- 3 70-1603 No municipal utility owned and operated by a

- 6 nonpayment of any past-due account unless such utility first gives
- 7 written notice by mail to any subscriber whose service is proposed
- 8 to be terminated at least seven days prior to termination. As to
- 9 any subscriber who has previously been identified as a welfare
- 10 recipient to the utility by the Department of Health and Human
- 11 Services, such notice shall be by certified mail and notice of such
- 12 proposed termination shall be given to the department.
- Sec. 2. Section 70-1605, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 14 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 15 70-1605 No public or private utility company, other than
- 16 a municipal utility owned and operated by a village, furnishing
- 17 water, natural gas, or electricity at retail in this state shall
- 18 discontinue service to any domestic subscriber for nonpayment of
- 19 any past-due account unless the utility company first gives notice
- 20 by first-class mail or in person to any subscriber whose service
- 21 is proposed to be terminated. If notice is given by first-class
- 22 mail, such mail shall be conspicuously marked as to its importance.
- 23 Service shall not be discontinued for at least seven days after
- 24 notice is sent or given. Holidays and weekends shall be excluded
- 25 from the seven days. As to any subscriber who has previously been

- 3 mail and notice of such proposed termination shall be given to the
