A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the State Electrical Board; to amend section
 81-2104, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide
 authority to adopt the National Electrical Code by rules
 and regulations instead of statute; and to repeal the
 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 81-2104, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 81-2104 The board shall have power to:
- 4 (1) Elect its own officers;
- 5 (2) Engage and fix the compensation of such officers,
- 6 inspectors, and employees as may be required in the performance of
- 7 its duties;
- 8 (3) Pay such other expenses as may be necessary in the
- 9 performance of its duties;
- 10 (4) Provide upon request such additional voluntary
- 11 inspections and reviews as it deems appropriate;
- 12 (5) Adopt, promulgate, and revise rules and regulations
- 13 necessary to enable it to carry into effect the State Electrical
- 14 Act. In adopting and promulgating such rules and regulations, the
- 15 board shall be governed by the minimum standards set forth in
- 16 the National Electrical Code issued and adopted by the National
- 17 Fire Protection Association. The board shall adopt the most recent
- 18 version of the National Electrical Code and any amendments to
- 19 the code before January 1 of the year following the issuance and
- 20 adoption of the code and any amendments thereto by the National
- 21 Fire Protection Association. Such adoption shall be included in the
- 22 rules and regulations and shall be effective on January 1 of the
- 23 year following the adoption. The most recent in 2005, Publication
- 24 Number $70-2005_7$ and amendments to the code adopted as of January 1_7
- 25 2003, which code and amendments adopted by the board as indicated

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1 by the rules and regulations shall be filed in the offices of the

- 2 Secretary of State and the board and shall be a public record. The
- 3 board shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations establishing
- 4 wiring standards that protect public safety and health and property
- 5 and that apply to all electrical wiring which is installed subject
- 6 to the State Electrical Act;
- 7 (6) Revoke, suspend, or refuse to renew any license or
- 8 registration granted pursuant to the State Electrical Act when the
- 9 licensee or registrant (a) violates any provision of the National
- 10 Electrical Code as adopted pursuant to subdivision (5) of this
- 11 section, the act, or any rule or regulation adopted and promulgated
- 12 pursuant to the act, (b) fails or refuses to pay any examination,
- 13 registration, or license renewal fee required by law, (c) is an
- 14 electrical contractor or master electrician and fails or refuses to
- 15 provide and keep in force a public liability insurance policy as
- 16 required by the board, or (d) violates any political subdivision's
- 17 approved inspection ordinances;
- 18 (7) Order disconnection of power to any electrical
- 19 installation that is proximately dangerous to health and property;
- 20 (8) Order removal of electrical wiring and apparatus from
- 21 premises when such wiring and apparatus is proximately dangerous to
- 22 health and property;
- 23 (9) Investigate, for the purpose of identifying dangerous
- 24 electrical wiring or violations of the National Electrical Code as
- 25 adopted pursuant to subdivision (5) of this section, any death by

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- 1 electrocution that occurs within the State of Nebraska;
- 2 (10) Refuse to renew any license granted pursuant to the
- 3 act when the licensee fails to submit evidence of completing the
- 4 continuing education requirements under section 81-2117.01;
- 5 (11) Provide for the amount and collection of fees for
- 6 inspection and other services;
- 7 (12) Adopt a seal, and the executive secretary shall have
- 8 the care and custody thereof; and
- 9 (13) Enforce the provisions of the National Electrical
- 10 Code as adopted pursuant to subdivision (5) of this section.
