A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend section 2-2634,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change pesticide
- 3 registration and renewal fees; to repeal the original
- 4 section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-2634, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-2634 (1) As a condition to registration or renewal of
- 4 registration as required by sections 2-2628 to 2-2633, an applicant
- 5 shall pay to the department a fee of two hundred dollars for each
- 6 pesticide to be registered that is not classified as a specialty
- 7 pesticide by the department and one hundred thirty-five dollars for
- 8 each pesticide to be registered that is classified as a specialty
- 9 pesticide by the department, except that the fee may be increased
- 10 by the director after a public hearing is held outlining the reason
- 11 for any proposed change in the fee. In no event shall such fee
- 12 exceed two hundred ten dollars for each pesticide to be registered.
- 13 All fees collected shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 14 credit as follows:
- 15 (a) For a pesticide that is classified as a specialty
- 16 pesticide:
- 17 (a) Thirty (i) Thirty-five dollars of each such fee to
- 18 the Noxious Weed Cash Fund as provided in section 2-958;
- 19 (b) Sixty (ii) Fifty-five dollars of each such fee to the
- 20 Buffer Strip Incentive Fund as provided in section 2-5106; and
- 21 (c) (iii) The remainder of each such fee, for a pesticide
- 22 that is not classified as a specialty pesticide, if any, to
- 23 the Natural Resources Water Quality Fund, and the remainder of
- 24 each such fee for a pesticide that is classified as a specialty
- 25 pesticide, if any, to the Pesticide Administrative Cash Fund; and-

1 (b) For a pesticide that is not classified as a specialty

- 2 pesticide:
- 3 (i) Thirty-five dollars of each such fee to the Noxious
- 4 Weed Cash Fund as provided in section 2-958;
- 5 (ii) Fifty-five dollars of each such fee to the Buffer
- 6 Strip Incentive Fund as provided in section 2-5106; and
- 7 (iii) The remainder of each such fee, if any, to the
- 8 Natural Resources Water Quality Fund.
- 9 (2) If a person fails to apply for renewal of
- 10 registration before January 1 of any year, such person, as a
- 11 condition to renewal, shall pay a late registration fee equal to
- 12 twenty-five percent of the fee due and owing per month, not to
- 13 exceed one hundred percent, for each product to be renewed in
- 14 addition to the renewal fee. The purpose of the late registration
- 15 fee is to cover the administrative costs associated with collecting
- 16 fees, and all money collected as a late registration fee shall
- 17 be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Pesticide
- 18 Administrative Cash Fund.
- 19 Sec. 2. Original section 2-2634, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 20 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 21 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 22 when passed and approved according to law.
