Section 1. Section 69-2403, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 69-2403 (1) Except as provided in this section and 4 section 69-2409, a person shall not purchase, lease, rent, or 5 receive transfer of a handgun until he or she has obtained a 6 certificate in accordance with section 69-2404. Except as provided 7 in this section and section 69-2409, a person shall not sell, 8 lease, rent, or transfer a handgun to a person who has not obtained 9 a certificate.

10 (2) The certificate shall not be required if:

11 (1) (a) The person acquiring the handgun is a licensed 12 firearms dealer under federal law;

13 (2) (b) The handgun is an antique handgun;

14 (3) (c) The person acquiring the handgun is authorized to
15 do so on behalf of a law enforcement agency;

16 (4) (d) The transfer is a temporary transfer of a handgun 17 and the transferee remains (a) (i) in the line of sight of the 18 transferor or (b) (ii) within the premises of an established 19 shooting facility; Θ

20 (5) (e) The transfer is between a person and his or
21 her spouse, sibling, parent, child, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, or
22 grandparent; or.

23 (f) The person acquiring the handgun is a holder of a
24 valid permit under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act.
