## A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to revenue and taxation; to provide for refund
- 3 and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. If, by judgment or final order of any court 1 2 of competent jurisdiction in this state entered on or after 3 January 1, 2009, in an action not pending on appeal, it has been adjudged and determined that any personal property, real property, or occupation tax, assessment, or penalty or any part 5 6 thereof was unconstitutional and such judgment or order was not 7 made in time to prevent the collection or payment of such tax, assessment, or penalty, then such tax, assessment, or penalty, 9 if not expended, which has been collected pursuant to such 10 unconstitutional tax, assessment, or penalty for the year such 11 tax, assessment, or penalty is determined to be unconstitutional 12 and for prior years beginning with the year the action challenging 13 the constitutionality was commenced may, without the necessity 14 of filing a claim therefor, be repaid and refunded in the 15 county where originally paid to the person paying such tax, 16 assessment, or penalty. If the tax, assessment, or penalty declared unconstitutional is applicable either throughout the state or in 17 taxing districts beyond the geographic jurisdiction of the court 18 19 making such declaration of unconstitutionality then, for purposes 20 of this section, a judgment or final order shall mean a judgment or 21 final order of the Supreme Court. This section is supplementary to 22 and does not replace section 77-1735. The refund may be made in the manner prescribed in section 77-1736.06 or applied to satisfy any 23 24 tax levied or assessed in the county.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect

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1 when passed and approved according to law.
