A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to elections; to amend sections 32-101, 32-808,

 and 32-939, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to

 change provisions relating to early voting; to repeal

 the original sections; and to outright repeal section

 32-939.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 32-101, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 32-101 Sections 32-101 to 32-1551 and section 4 of this
- act shall be known and may be cited as the Election Act. 4
- Sec. 2. Section 32-808, Reissue Revised Statutes of 5
- Nebraska, is amended to read: 6

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- 32-808 (1) Ballots Except as otherwise provided in 8 section 4 of this act, ballots for early voting and applications 9 shall be ready for delivery to registered voters at least
- 10 thirty-five days prior to each statewide primary or general
- 11 election and at least fifteen days prior to all other elections. (2)
- 12 Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, upon request for a
- 13 ballot, a ballot for early voting shall be forwarded to each voter
- 14 meeting the criteria of section 32-939 at least forty-five days
- 15 prior to any election. The election commissioner or county clerk
- 16 shall not forward any ballot for early voting if the election to
- which such ballot pertains has already been held. If the ballot 17
- 18 has not been printed in sufficient time to meet the requirements
- 19 of this subsection, the election commissioner or county clerk shall
- 20 issue a special ballot at least sixty days prior to an election to
- 21 each voter meeting the criteria of section 32-939 upon the written
- 22 request by such voter requesting the special ballot. A complete
- 23 list of the nominated candidates and issues to be voted upon by a
- 24 voter meeting the criteria of such section shall be included with
- 25 the special ballot by the election commissioner or county clerk. A

1 notice shall be sent with the primary election ballot stating that

- 2 the voter must request a general election ballot unless such voter
- 3 has requested both the primary and general election ballots. If the
- 4 voter has requested both ballots, a notice shall be sent with the
- 5 primary election ballot stating that the general election ballot
- 6 will be sent to the same address unless otherwise notified.
- 7 (3) For purposes of this section, a special ballot means
- 8 a ballot prescribed by the Secretary of State which contains
- 9 the titles of all offices being contested at such election and
- 10 permits the voter to vote by writing in the names of the specific
- 11 candidates or the decision on any issue.
- 12 (4) (2) The election commissioner or county clerk shall
- 13 publish in a newspaper of general circulation in the county an
- 14 application form to be used by registered voters in making an
- 15 application for a ballot for early voting after the ballots become
- 16 available. The publication of the application shall not be required
- 17 if the election is held by mail pursuant to sections 32-952 to
- 18 32-959.
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 32-939, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 20 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 21 32-939 (1) The As provided in section 4 of this act, the
- 22 persons listed in this subsection who are residents of Nebraska
- 23 but who reside outside the United States shall be allowed to
- 24 simultaneously register to vote and make application for ballots
- 25 for all elections in a calendar year through the use of the Federal

1 Post Card Application or a personal letter which includes the same

- 2 information as appears on the Federal Post Card Application:
- 3 (a) Members of the armed forces of the United States or
- 4 the United States Merchant Marine, and their spouses and dependents
- 5 residing with them;
- 6 (b) Citizens temporarily residing outside of the United
- 7 States and the District of Columbia; and
- 8 (c) Overseas citizens.
- 9 (2) An omission of required information, except the
 10 political party affiliation of the applicant, may prevent the
 11 processing of an application and mailing of ballots. The request
- 12 for any ballots and a registration application shall be sent to
- 13 the election commissioner or county clerk of the county of the
- 14 applicant's residence. The request may be sent at any time in
- 15 the same calendar year as the election, except that the request
- 16 shall be received by the election commissioner or county clerk not
- 17 later than the third Friday preceding an election to vote in that
- 18 election. If so requested, ballots may be sent for all subsequent
- 19 elections held in the county in that calendar year.
- 20 (3) Any person meeting the criteria in subsection (1) of
- 21 this section may cast a ballot by the use of the Federal Write-In
- 22 Absentee Ballot. The Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot may be used
- 23 for all elections. If a person casting a ballot using the Federal
- 24 Write-In Absentee Ballot is not a registered voter, the information
- 25 submitted in the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot transmission

1 envelope shall be treated as a voter registration application.

- 2 (4) Any person meeting the criteria in subsection (1)
- 3 of this section requesting a ballot under this section or the
- 4 special ballot described in section 32-808 may receive and return
- 5 the ballot and the oath prescribed in subsection (2) of section
- 6 32-947 using any method of transmission authorized by the Secretary
- 7 of State.
- 8 (2)(a) As provided in section 4 of this act, a person
- 9 who is the age of an elector and a citizen of the United States
- 10 residing outside the United States, who has never resided in the
- 11 United States, who has not registered to vote in any other state of
- 12 the United States, and who has a parent registered to vote within
- 13 this state shall be eligible to register to vote and vote in one
- 14 county in which either one of his or her parents is a registered
- 15 voter.
- 16 (b) A person registering to vote or voting pursuant
- 17 to this subsection shall sign and enclose with the registration
- 18 application and with the ballot being voted a form provided by
- 19 the election commissioner or county clerk substantially as follows:
- 20 I am the age of an elector and a citizen of the United States
- 21 residing outside the United States, I have never resided in the
- 22 United States, I have not registered to vote in any other state
- 23 of the United States, and I have a parent registered to vote
- 24 in County, Nebraska. I hereby declare, under penalty
- 25 of election falsification, a Class IV felony, that the statements

- 1 above are true to the best of my knowledge.
- 2 THE PENALTY FOR ELECTION FALSIFICATION IS IMPRISONMENT
- 3 FOR UP TO FIVE YEARS OR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS,
- 4 OR BOTH.
- 5 (Signature of Voter)
- 6 Sec. 4. (1) Upon request for a ballot, a ballot for early
- 7 voting shall be forwarded to each voter meeting the criteria of
- 8 section 32-939 at least forty-five days prior to any election.
- 9 (2) An omission of required information, except the
- 10 political party affiliation of the applicant, may prevent the
- 11 processing of an application for and mailing of ballots. The
- 12 request for any ballots and a registration application shall be
- 13 sent to the election commissioner or county clerk of the county of
- 14 the applicant's residence. The request may be sent at any time in
- 15 the same calendar year as the election, except that the request
- 16 shall be received by the election commissioner or county clerk
- 17 not later than the third Friday preceding an election to vote
- 18 in that election. If an applicant fails to indicate his or her
- 19 political party affiliation on the application, the applicant shall
- 20 be registered as nonpartisan.
- 21 (3) A person described in section 32-939 may register
- 22 to vote through the use of the Federal Post Card Application
- 23 or a personal letter which includes the same information as
- 24 appears on the Federal Post Card Application and may simultaneously
- 25 make application for ballots for all elections in a calendar

1 year. The person may indicate a preference for ballots and other

- 2 election materials to be delivered via facsimile transmission or
- 3 electronic mail by indicating such preference on the Federal Post
- 4 Card Application. If the person indicates such a preference, the
- 5 election commissioner or county clerk shall accommodate the voter's
- 6 preference.
- 7 (4) If the ballot for early voting has not been printed
- 8 in sufficient time to meet the request and special requirements
- 9 of a voter meeting the criteria of section 32-939, the election
- 10 commissioner or county clerk may issue a special ballot at least
- 11 sixty days prior to an election to such a voter upon a written
- 12 request by such voter requesting the special ballot. For purposes
- of this subsection, a special ballot means a ballot prescribed by
- 14 the Secretary of State which contains the titles of all offices
- 15 being contested at such election and permits the voter to vote by
- 16 writing in the names of the specific candidates or the decision on
- 17 any issue. The election commissioner or county clerk shall include
- 18 with the special ballot a complete list of the nominated candidates
- 19 and issues to be voted upon by the voter which are known at the
- 20 <u>time of the voter's request.</u>
- 21 (5) Any person meeting the criteria in section 32-939 may
- 22 cast a ballot by the use of the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot.
- 23 The Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot may be used for all elections.
- 24 If a person casting a ballot using the Federal Write-In Absentee
- 25 Ballot is not a registered voter, the information submitted in

1 the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot transmission envelope shall be

- 2 treated as a voter registration application.
- 3 (6) Any person requesting a ballot under this section may
- 4 receive and return the ballot and the oath prescribed in subsection
- 5 (2) of section 32-947 using any method of transmission authorized
- 6 by the Secretary of State.
- 7 (7) The Secretary of State shall develop a process for a
- 8 person casting a ballot under this section to check the status of
- 9 his or her ballot via the Internet or a toll-free telephone call.
- 10 Sec. 5. Original sections 32-101, 32-808, and 32-939,
- 11 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
