1 Section 1. Section 29-2412, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 29-2412 (1) Whenever it is made satisfactorily to appear
- 4 to the district court, or to the county judge of the proper county,
- 5 after all legal means have been exhausted, that any person who is
- 6 subject to being or is confined in jail for any fine or costs of
- 7 prosecution for any criminal offense has no estate with which to
- 8 pay such fine or costs, it shall be the duty of such court or
- 9 judge, on his or her own motion or upon the motion of the person
- 10 so confined, to discharge such person from further imprisonment for
- 11 such fine or costs, which discharge shall operate as a complete
- 12 release of such fine or costs.
- 13 (2) Nothing in this section shall authorize any person to
- 14 be discharged from imprisonment before the expiration of the time
- 15 for which he or she may be sentenced to be imprisoned, as part
- 16 of his or her punishment, or when such person shall default on a
- 17 payment due pursuant to an installment agreement arranged by the
- 18 court.
- 19 (3) Any person held in custody for nonpayment of a fine
- 20 or costs or for default on an installment shall be entitled to a
- 21 credit on the fine, costs, or installment of sixty eighty dollars
- 22 for each day so held. In no case shall a person held in custody
- 23 for nonpayment of a fine or costs be held in such custody for more
- 24 days than the maximum number to which he or she could have been
- 25 sentenced if the penalty set by law includes the possibility of
