

One Hundred First Legislature - First Session - 2009 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 656

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Nebraska residents, like most of the country, are facing a crisis in the availability and affordability of health care. LB 656, the Health Care Accessibility and Affordability Act, creates the Health Care Plan Advisory Council. This council would be made up of members of the Legislature and representatives from health care, business, insurers, consumers, and consumer advocates. The council is charged with developing recommendations for a comprehensive plan which would include such things as; the provision of health insurance to all residents of Nebraska, encouraging healthy lifestyles among Nebraskans, encouraging health care providers to practice in underserved areas, reducing unnecessary health costs, promoting patient safety, and establishing a statewide health information system.
