Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 610 adds state elective officers to the list of officials subject to recall.

State elective office is defined in the bill to include: Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, State Treasurer, Attorney General, the members of the Legislature, and a member of a board or commission with one or more election districts of more than one county.

The Secretary of State will act as filing clerk and will order the recall elections for the state elective officers
