LB 1049 would have no fiscal impact on state agencies.

LB 1049 would restrict the purchase of manhole covers and sewer grates by a secondary metals recycler. Recyclers could only accept covers and grates if they were 1) submitted by an authorized representative of the political subdivision that owns the covers or grates, or 2) submitted by a third party who has documentation from a political subdivision evidencing the third party's right to possess and sell the covers or grates. It is estimated that any administrative costs to comply with LB 1049 could be absorbed by political subdivisions.
