## A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to amend sections 44-3521 and
2	44-3526, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to define
3	and redefine terms; to change contract coverage under the
4	Motor Vehicle Service Contract Reimbursement Insurance
5	Act; and to repeal the original sections.
6	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 44-3521, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 44-3521 For purposes of the Motor Vehicle Service 4 Contract Reimbursement Insurance Act: 5 (1) Director means the Director of Insurance; б (2) Incidental costs means expenses specified in a motor 7 vehicle service contract that are incurred by the service contract 8 holder due to the failure of a vehicle protection product to perform 9 as provided in the contract. Incidental costs include, but are not 10 limited to, insurance policy deductibles, rental vehicle charges, the difference between the actual value of the stolen vehicle at the time 11 12 of theft and the cost of a replacement vehicle, sales taxes, 13 registration fees, transaction fees, and mechanical inspection fees. Incidental costs may be reimbursed in either a fixed amount specified 14 15 in the motor vehicle service contract or sales agreement or by use of 16 a formula itemizing specific incidental costs incurred by the service 17 <u>contract holder;</u> (2) (3) Mechanical breakdown insurance means a policy, 18 19 contract, or agreement that undertakes to perform or provide repair 20 or replacement service, or indemnification for such service, for the operational or structural failure of a motor vehicle due to defect in 21

22 materials or workmanship or normal wear and tear and that is issued 23 by an insurance company authorized to do business in this state;

24 (3) (4) Motor vehicle means any motor vehicle as defined 25 in section 60-339;

2	contract or agreement given for consideration over and above the
3	lease or purchase price of a motor vehicle that undertakes to perform
4	or provide repair or replacement service, or indemnification for such
5	service, for the operational or structural failure of a motor vehicle
б	due to defect in materials or workmanship or normal wear and tear but
7	does not include mechanical breakdown insurance. $\dot{ au}$
8	<u>(b) Motor vehicle service contract also includes a</u>
9	contract or agreement that is effective for a specified duration and
10	paid for by means other than the purchase of a motor vehicle to
11	perform any one or more of the following:
12	(i) The repair or replacement of tires or wheels on a
13	motor vehicle damaged as a result of coming into contact with road
14	hazards;
15	(ii) The removal of dents, dings, or creases on a motor
16	vehicle that can be repaired using the process of paintless dent
17	removal without affecting the existing paint finish and without
18	replacing vehicle body panels, sanding, bonding, or painting;
19	(iii) The repair of chips or cracks in or replacement of
20	motor vehicle windshields as a result of damage caused by road
21	hazards;
22	(iv) The replacement of a motor vehicle key or keyfob in
23	the event the key or keyfob becomes inoperable or is lost;
24	(v) The payment of specified incidental costs as the
25	result of a failure of a vehicle protection product to perform as

2 (vi) Other products and services approved by the director; 3 4 (5) (6) Motor vehicle service contract provider means a 5 person who issues, makes, provides, sells, or offers to sell a motor б vehicle service contract, except that motor vehicle service contract 7 provider does not include an insurer as defined in section 44-103; 8 (6) (7) Motor vehicle service contract reimbursement 9 insurance policy means a policy of insurance meeting the requirements in section 44-3523 that provides coverage for all obligations and 10 liabilities incurred by a motor vehicle service contract provider 11 12 under the terms of motor vehicle service contracts issued by the 13 provider; and 14 (8) Road hazards means hazards that are encountered during normal driving conditions, including, but not limited to, 15 16 potholes, rocks, wood debris, metal parts, glass, plastic, curbs, or <u>composite scraps;</u> 17 (7) (9) Service contract holder means a person who 18 19 purchases a motor vehicle service contract; and -20 (10)(a) Vehicle protection product means a vehicle protection device, system, or service that: 21 22 (i) Is installed on or applied to a vehicle; 23 (ii) Is designed to prevent loss or damage to a vehicle from a specific cause; and 24 25 (iii) Includes a written warranty.

2	limited to, chemical additives, alarm systems, body part marking
3	products, steering locks, window etch products, pedal and ignition
4	locks, fuel and ignition kill switches, and electronic, radio, and
5	satellite tracking devices.
