A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to agriculture; to amend sections 2-3602, 2-3623,
2-3632, and 2-3633, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
to restate intent; to change a fee, reporting
requirements, and the source and use of a fund under the
Nebraska Corn Resources Act; to provide operative dates;
and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 2-3602, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-3602 It is declared to be the public policy of the
- 4 State of Nebraska to protect and foster the health, prosperity, and
- 5 general welfare of its people by protecting and stabilizing the corn
- 6 industry and the economy of the areas producing corn. The Corn
- 7 Development, Utilization, and Marketing Board shall be the agency of
- 8 the State of Nebraska for such purpose. In connection with and in
- 9 <u>furtherance of such purpose</u>, it is declared to be in the interest of
- 10 the public welfare of the state that the producers of corn be
- 11 permitted and encouraged to develop, carry out, and participate in
- 12 programs of research, education, market development, and promotion.
- 13 It is the purpose of sections 2-3601 to 2-3635 the Nebraska Corn
- 14 Resources Act to provide the authorization and to prescribe the
- 15 necessary procedures whereby corn producers in this state may finance
- 16 programs to achieve the activities expressed in sections 2-3601 to
- 17 $\frac{2-3635}{1}$ the act.
- 18 Sec. 2. Section 2-3623, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 19 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 20 2-3623 There is hereby levied a fee of not to exceed
- 21 <u>four-tenths five-tenths</u> of a cent per bushel upon all corn sold
- 22 through commercial channels in Nebraska or delivered in Nebraska. The
- 23 fee shall be paid by the grower at the time of sale or delivery and
- 24 shall be collected by the first purchaser. Under the Nebraska Corn
- 25 Resources Act, no corn shall be subject to the fee more than once.

1 Sec. 3. Section 2-3632, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 2-3632 The board shall make and publish prepare and make
- 4 <u>available</u> an annual report on or before January 1 of each year, which
- 5 report shall set forth in detail the income received from the corn
- 6 assessment for the previous year and shall include:
- 7 (1) The expenditure of all funds by the board during the
- 8 previous year for the administration of sections 2-3601 to 2-3635;
- 9 <u>the Nebraska Corn Resources Act;</u>
- 10 (2) The action taken by the board on all contracts
- 11 requiring the expenditure of funds by the board;
- 12 (3) Copies A description of all such contracts;
- 13 (4) Detailed A detailed explanation of all programs
- 14 relating to the discovery, promotion, and development of markets and
- 15 industries for the utilization of corn, the direct expense associated
- 16 with each program, and copies of such programs if in writing; and
- 17 (5) The name and address of each member of the board and
- 18 a copy of all rules and regulations promulgated by the board.
- 19 Such report <u>and a copy of all contracts requiring</u>
- 20 <u>expenditure of funds by the board</u> shall be available to the public
- 21 upon request.
- 22 Sec. 4. Section 2-3633, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 23 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 24 2-3633 The State Treasurer is hereby directed to
- 25 establish and set up in the treasury of the State of Nebraska a fund

1 to be known as the The Nebraska Corn Development, Utilization, and

- 2 Marketing Fund, to which fund is created. All fees collected pursuant
- 3 to the Nebraska Corn Resources Act and any repayments relating to the
- 4 <u>fund, including license fees or royalties, shall be credited, to the</u>
- 5 <u>fund</u> for the uses and purposes of the Nebraska Corn Resources Act act
- 6 and its enforcement. , all taxes collected by the board pursuant to
- 7 the act. Such fund shall be expended solely for the administration of
- 8 the act. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
- 9 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
- 10 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 11 Sec. 5. Sections 2 and 6 of this act become operative on
- 12 October 1, 2012. The other sections of this act become operative on
- 13 their effective date.
- Sec. 6. Original section 2-3623, Reissue Revised Statutes
- of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 16 Sec. 7. Original sections 2-3602, 2-3632, and 2-3633,
- 17 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
