## A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to natural gas; to create the Natural Gas Fuel
- Board; and to provide powers and duties.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) The Natural Gas Fuel Board is hereby

- 2 established to advise the State Energy Office regarding the promotion
- 3 of natural gas as a motor vehicle fuel in Nebraska. The board shall
- 4 provide recommendations relating to:
- 5 <u>(a) Distribution, infrastructure, and workforce</u>
- 6 development for natural gas to be used as a motor vehicle fuel;
- 7 (b) Loans, grants, and tax incentives to encourage the
- 8 use of natural gas as a motor vehicle fuel for individuals and public
- 9 <u>and private fleets; and</u>
- 10 <u>(c) Such other matters as it deems appropriate.</u>
- 11 (2) The board shall consist of eight members appointed by
- 12 the Governor. The Governor shall make the initial appointments by
- 13 October 1, 2012. The board shall include:
- 14 (a) One member representing a jurisdictional utility as
- 15 <u>defined in section 66-1802;</u>
- 16 (b) One member representing a metropolitan utilities
- 17 district;
- 18 (c) One member representing the interests of the
- 19 <u>transportation industry in the state;</u>
- 20 (d) One member representing the interests of the business
- 21 community in the state, specifically fueling station owners or
- 22 <u>operators;</u>
- 23 (e) One member representing natural gas marketers or
- 24 pipelines in the state;
- 25 <u>(f) One member representing automobile dealerships or</u>

- 1 repair businesses in the state;
- 2 (g) One member representing labor interests in the state;
- 3 and
- 4 (h) One member representing environmental interests in
- 5 the state, specifically air quality.
- 6 (3) All appointments shall be subject to the approval of
- 7 a majority of the members of the Legislature if the Legislature is in
- 8 session, and if the Legislature is not in session, any appointment to
- 9 fill a vacancy shall be temporary until the next session of the
- 10 Legislature, at which time a majority of the members of the
- 11 Legislature may approve or disapprove such appointment.
- 12 (4) Members shall be appointed for terms of four years,
- 13 except that of the initial appointees the terms of the members
- 14 representing a jurisdictional utility and a metropolitan utilities
- district shall expire on September 30, 2015, the terms of the members
- 16 representing the transportation industry, the business community,
- 17 natural gas marketers or pipelines, and automobile dealerships or
- 18 repair businesses shall expire on September 30, 2014, and the terms
- 19 of the members representing labor and environmental interests shall
- 20 expire on September 30, 2013. Members may be reappointed. A member
- 21 shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified.
- 22 (5) A vacancy on the board shall exist in the event of
- 23 death, disability, resignation, or removal for cause of a member. Any
- 24 vacancy on the board arising other than from the expiration of a term
- 25 shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term.

1 An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be made by the Governor with

- 2 the approval of a majority of the Legislature, and any person so
- 3 appointed shall have the same qualifications as the person whom he or
- 4 she succeeds.
- 5 <u>(6) The board shall meet at least once annually.</u>
- 6 (7) The members shall not be reimbursed for expenses
- 7 <u>associated with carrying out their duties as members.</u>
- 8 (8) The State Energy Office shall provide administrative
- 9 support to the board as necessary so that the board may carry out its
- 10 <u>duties</u>.
