A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure  
2 Commission; to amend section 49-14,120, Reissue Revised  
3 Statutes of Nebraska; to eliminate per diems for members  
4 of the commission as prescribed; to provide an operative  
5 date; to repeal the original section; and to declare an  
6 emergency.  
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 49-14,120, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   49-14,120 ~~The Secretary of State shall receive no~~  
4 ~~compensation for services as a commission member other than any~~  
5 ~~salary allowed by law, but~~ All members of the commission shall be  
6 reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. ~~The appointed members~~  
7 ~~shall be paid a per diem of fifty dollars for each day actually and~~  
8 ~~necessarily engaged in the performance of their duties as members of~~  
9 ~~such commission in addition to such expense allowance. Reimbursement~~  
10 ~~for expenses shall be as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.~~

11                   Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2011.

12                   Sec. 3. Original section 49-14,120, Reissue Revised  
13 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

14                   Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
15 when passed and approved according to law.
