1	FOR AN ACT	relating to motor vehicle park entry permits; to amend
2		section 37-438, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
3		section 37-440, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
4		2010; to change fees for annual and temporary permits and
5		fees for issuance of the permits; to change a provision
6		relating to display of permits; to provide an operative
7		date; and to repeal the original sections.

1 Section 1. Section 37-438, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 37-438 (1) The commission shall devise permits in two
- 4 forms: Annual and temporary.
- 5 (2) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and
- 6 shall be valid through December 31 in the year for which the permit
- 7 is issued. The fee for the annual permit for a resident motor vehicle
- 8 shall be not more than twenty-twenty-five dollars per permit. The fee
- 9 for the annual permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall not be
- 10 more than twenty-five thirty dollars. The commission shall establish
- 11 such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations.
- 12 (3) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and
- 13 shall be valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The
- 14 fee for the temporary permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be
- 15 not more than four-five dollars. The fee for the temporary permit for
- 16 a nonresident motor vehicle shall not be more than five-six_dollars.
- 17 The commission shall establish such fees by the adoption and
- 18 promulgation of rules and regulations. The commission may issue
- 19 temporary permits which are either valid for any area or valid for a
- 20 single area.

- 23 37-440 (1) The commission shall prescribe the type and
- 24 design of permits and the method of display of permits for for

1 vehicles. The commission may provide for the electronic issuance of

- 2 permits and may enter into contracts to procure necessary services
- 3 and supplies for the electronic issuance of permits.
- 4 (2) The permits may be procured from the central and
- 5 district offices of the commission, at areas of the Nebraska state
- 6 park system where commission offices are maintained, from self-
- 7 service vending stations at designated park areas, from designated
- 8 commission employees, through Internet sales from the commission's
- 9 web site, from appropriate offices of county government, and from
- 10 various private persons, firms, or corporations designated by the
- 11 commission as permit agents. The commission and county offices or
- 12 private persons, firms, or corporations designated by the commission
- 13 as permit agents shall be entitled to collect and retain a fee of not
- 14 less than twenty-five cents and not more than thirty-five cents, one
- 15 <u>dollar</u>, as established by the commission pursuant to section 37-327,
- 16 for each permit as reimbursement for the clerical work of issuing the
- 17 permits and remitting therefor. The commission shall be entitled to
- 18 collect and retain a fee of one dollar for each permit sold through
- 19 its web site as reimbursement for the clerical work and postage
- 20 associated with issuing the permit.
- 21 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2012.
