A BILL

L	FOR AN ACT	relating to the Game and Parks Commission; to amend
2		section 37-354, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
3		2010; to authorize the commission to convey certain real
1		estate for park purposes; to prescribe conditions
5		relating to the conveyance, operation, and maintenance of
5		the real estate; to provide duties for the commission; to
7		harmonize provisions; to repeal the original section; and
3		to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The Game and Parks Commission is authorized to 2 convey to the village of Ayr for public park purposes the following 3 described real estate, now known as Crystal Lake State Recreation 4 Area, situated in the county of Adams, in the State of Nebraska, to-5 wit: (1) That part of the southeast quarter of section 28, 6 7 township 6 north, range 10 west of the 6th principal meridian, in 8 Adams County, Nebraska, described as follows: Begin at a stone at the 9 northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section 28, township 6 10 north, range 10 west; thence south along the section line 254 feet to a point where the south right-of-way line of the Burlington-Northern 11 12 Railroad intersects the said section line, said point being the point 13 of beginning for the parcel herein conveyed; thence northwesterly along the south right-of-way line of the Burlington-Northern 14 Railroad, 648 feet to an iron pin; thence left 95 degrees, 28 15 16 minutes, 414.7 feet to an iron pin; thence left 38 degrees, 21 minutes, 324.2 feet; thence right 57 degrees, 15 minutes, 805.8 feet 17 to an iron pin; thence right 60 degrees, 13 minutes, 48.9 feet to an 18 iron pin; thence left 51 degrees, 20 minutes, 1,026.7 feet to an iron 19 20 pin; thence left 62 degrees, 21 minutes, 208.9 feet to an iron pin on 21 the south side of section 28; thence left 58 degrees, 38 minutes, 22 186.5 feet along the section line to an iron pin; thence left 48 degrees, 22 minutes, 371.7 feet to an iron pin; thence left 21 23 degrees, 30 minutes, 574 feet to an iron pin; thence right 70 24 25 degrees, 20 minutes, 605.8 feet to an iron pin on the section line

1 between sections 27 and 28; thence north along said section line

2 1,588 feet to the point of beginning, containing 32.79 acres more or

3 <u>less;</u> 4 (2) That part of the southwest quarter of section 27, 5 township 6 north, range 10 west, in Adams County, Nebraska, described as follows: Begin at a stone at the northwest corner of the southwest 6 7 quarter of section 27, township 6 north, range 10 west; thence south 8 along the section line 254 feet to a point where the south right-of-9 way line of the Burlington-Northern Railroad intersects the said 10 section line, said point being the point of beginning for the parcel 11 herein conveyed; thence southeasterly along the south right-of-way 12 line of said railroad 265.7 feet to an iron pin; thence right 81 13 degrees, 14 minutes, 272 feet to an iron pin; thence left 52 degrees, 14 50 minutes, 151 feet to an iron pin; thence left 12 degrees, 165 feet to an iron pin; thence right 19 degrees, 06 minutes, 211.5 feet to an 15 iron pin; thence right 6 degrees, 36 minutes, 132 feet to an iron 16 pin; thence right 6 degrees, 34 minutes, 198.2 feet to an iron pin; 17 thence left 6 degrees, 35 minutes, 198 feet to an iron pin; thence 18 right 10 degrees, 22 minutes, 132.3 feet to an iron pin; thence right 19 20 13 degrees, 54 minutes, 132 feet to an iron pin; thence right 7 21 degrees, 15 minutes, 132 feet; thence right 13 degrees, 05 minutes, 22 120.5 feet; thence left 15 degrees, 28 minutes, 131.8 feet; thence right 31 degrees, 10 minutes, 66 feet; thence right 34 degrees, 14 23 minutes, 99 feet; thence right 23 degrees, 04 minutes, 157.8 feet; 24 thence right 19 degrees, 19 minutes, 264 feet; thence right 9 25

degrees, 20 minutes, 642.6 feet to a point on the north and south 1 dividing line between sections 27 and 28 and 812 feet north of the 2 3 southwest corner of section 27; thence north along the section line, 4 1,588 feet to the place of beginning, containing 30.22 acres; and 5 (3) That part of the southwest quarter of section 27, 6 township 6 north, range 10 west of the 6th principal meridian, in 7 Adams County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows: To 8 ascertain the point of beginning, begin at the northwest corner of 9 the southwest quarter of section 27, township 6 north, range 10 west; 10 thence south along the section line 254 feet of the point where the 11 south right-of-way line of the Burlington-Northern Railroad 12 intersects the said section line; thence southeasterly along the 13 south right-of-way line of said railroad 265.70 feet; thence deflecting right 81 degrees, 14 minutes, for a distance of 55.63 feet 14 to the actual point of beginning; thence continuing on the same 15 16 course 216.37 feet; thence deflecting left 52 degrees, 50 minutes, 17 for a distance of 38.57 feet; thence deflecting left 127 degrees, 01 minute for a distance of 130.48 feet; thence deflecting left 8 18 degrees, 40 minutes, for a distance of 59.87 feet; thence deflecting 19 20 left 15 degrees, 24 minutes, for a distance of 54.80 feet to the 21 actual point of beginning and containing 0.154 acres, a little more 22 or a little less as surveyed by Edwin D. Benjamin. 23 If the village of Ayr ceases to operate the lands 24 conveyed as a public park and recreation area, title to such lands

shall revert to the Game and Parks Commission.

- 3 37-354 Property conveyed by the commission pursuant to
- 4 sections 90-272 and 90-273 and section 1 of this act shall be
- 5 operated and maintained as follows:
- 6 (1) The property shall be maintained so as to appear
- 7 attractive and inviting to the public;
- 8 (2) Sanitation and sanitary facilities shall be
- 9 maintained in accordance with applicable health standards;
- 10 (3) Properties shall be kept reasonably open, accessible,
- 11 and safe for public use. Fire prevention and similar activities shall
- 12 be maintained for proper public safety;
- 13 (4) Buildings, roads, trails, and other structures and
- 14 improvements shall be kept in reasonable repair throughout their
- 15 estimated lifetime to prevent undue deterioration and to encourage
- 16 public use; and
- 17 (5) The facility shall be kept open for public use at
- 18 reasonable hours and times of the year, according to the type of area
- 19 or facility.
- The commission shall be responsible for compliance and
- 21 enforcement of the requirements set forth in this section.

- Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 25 when passed and approved according to law.
