1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$226,750 from the 2 General Fund for FY2012-13 to the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska for the University of Nebraska Medical Center's College 3 of Public Health, for Program 781, to aid in carrying out the 4 5 provisions of Legislative Bill 985, One Hundred Second Legislature, 6 Second Session, 2012. 7 Sec. 2. On July 1, 2012, or as soon thereafter as 8 administratively possible, the State Treasurer shall transfer 9 \$226,750 from the Community Corrections Uniform Data Analysis Cash 10 Fund to the General Fund as authorized under section 47-632. Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$8,408,817 from 11 12 the General Fund for FY2012-13 and (2) \$8,408,817 from the General 13 Fund for FY2013-14 to the Supreme Court, for Program 435, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 985, One Hundred 14 15 Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012. 16 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not 17 exceed \$895,612 for FY2012-13 or \$895,612 for FY2013-14. 18 Sec. 4.
