- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1356 <u>and section 2 of this</u>
- 4 <u>act</u>shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) No person shall enter into a motor vehicle
- 6 without the permission of the owner for the purpose of committing any
- 7 <u>crime.</u>
- 8 (2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section shall
- 9 be a Class II misdemeanor for a first offense, a Class I misdemeanor
- 10 for a second offense, and a Class IV felony for third or subsequent
- offense.

- 13 treated as a separate and distinct offense from any other offense
- 14 arising out of acts alleged to have been committed while the person
