Section 1. Section 39-1365.01, Revised Statutes
 Cumulative Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:

3 39-1365.01 (1) The Department of Roads shall be responsible for developing a specific and long-range state highway 4 5 system plan. The department shall annually formulate plans to meet 6 the state highway system needs of all facets of the state and shall 7 assign priorities for such needs. The department shall, on or before 8 December 1 of each year, present such plans to the Legislature. The 9 plans shall be referred to the appropriate standing committees of the 10 Legislature for review. The department shall consider the preservation of the existing state highway system asset as its 11 12 primary priority except as may otherwise be provided in state or 13 federal law. In establishing secondary priorities, the department 14 shall consider a variety of factors, including, but not limited to, 15 current and projected traffic volume, safety requirements, whether local matching funds are available for the project, economic 16 development needs, current and projected demographic trends, and 17 enhancement of the quality of life for all Nebraska citizens. The 18 state highway system plan shall include the designation of those 19 20 portions of the state highway system which shall be expressways.

21 (2) For purposes of this section, local matching funds
22 means the funding available for a project from a county,
23 municipality, or joint entity consisting of counties and
24 municipalities.
