7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 48-622.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 48-622.02 (1) There is hereby created in the state 4 treasury a special fund to be known as the The Nebraska Training and 5 Support Trust Fund is hereby created. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer 6 7 pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State 8 Funds Investment Act. All money deposited or paid into the fund is 9 hereby appropriated and made available to the commissioner. No expenditures shall be made from the fund without the written 10 authorization of the Governor upon the recommendation of 11 the 12 commissioner. Any interest earned on money in the State Unemployment 13 Insurance Trust Fund shall be credited to the Nebraska Training and 14 Support Trust Fund.

15 (2) Money in the Nebraska Training and Support Trust Fund 16 shall be used for (a) administrative costs of establishing, assessing, collecting, and maintaining state unemployment insurance 17 tax liability and payments, (b) administrative costs of creating, 18 19 maintaining, and dissolving the State Unemployment Insurance Trust 20 Fund and the Nebraska Training and Support Trust Fund, (c) support of 21 public and private job training programs designed to train, retrain, 22 or upgrade work skills of existing Nebraska workers, (d) support of 23 public and private on-site job training programs designed to train 24 Nebraskans currently receiving unemployment insurance benefits, (e) 25 recruitment of workers to Nebraska, (e) (f) training new employees of

expanding Nebraska businesses, (f) (g) the costs of creating a common web portal for the attraction of businesses and workers to Nebraska, and (g) (h) payment of unemployment insurance benefits if solvency of the state's account in the Unemployment Trust Fund and of the State Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund so require.

(3) There is hereby created within the Nebraska Training б 7 and Support Trust Fund a separate account to be known as the 8 Administrative Costs Reserve Account. Money shall be allocated from the Nebraska Training and Support Trust Fund to the Administrative 9 Costs Reserve Account in amounts sufficient to pay the anticipated 10 11 administrative costs identified in subdivisions (2)(a) through (g)12 (h) of this section. The administrative costs determined to be 13 applicable to creation and operation of the State Unemployment 14 Insurance Trust Fund and the Nebraska Training and Support Trust Fund 15 shall be paid out of the Administrative Costs Reserve Account.

Sec. 2. Section 48-622.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

18 48-622.03 (1) There is hereby created as of January 1, 19 1996, the Nebraska Worker Training Board consisting of seven members 20 appointed and serving for terms determined by the Governor as 21 follows:

(a) A representative of employers in Nebraska;
(b) A representative of employees in Nebraska;
(c) A representative of the public;
(d) The Commissioner of Labor or a designee;

(e) The Director of Economic Development or a designee; 1 2 (f) The Commissioner of Education or a designee; and 3 (g) The chairperson of the governing board of the Nebraska Community College Association or a designee. 4 5 (2) Beginning July 1, 1996, and annually thereafter, the Governor shall appoint a chairperson for the board. The chairperson 6 7 shall be either the representative of the employers, the 8 representative of the employees, or the representative of the public. 9 (3) Beginning July 1, 1996, and annually thereafter the board shall prepare an annual program plan for the upcoming fiscal 10 year containing guidelines for the program financed by the Nebraska 11 12 Training and Support Trust Fund. The guidelines shall include, but 13 not be limited to, guidelines for certifying training providers, criteria for evaluating requests for the use of money under section 14 48-622.02, and guidelines for requiring employers to provide matching 15 16 funds. The guidelines shall give priority to training that contributes to the expansion of the Nebraska workforce, that results 17 in employment for recipients of unemployment insurance benefits, and 18

(4) Beginning September 1, 1997, and annually thereafter, the board shall provide a report to the Governor covering the activities of the program financed by the Nebraska Training and Support Trust Fund for the previous fiscal year. The report shall contain an assessment of the effectiveness of the program and its administration.
