(1) When the juvenile court has ordered 1 2 treatment or services for a juvenile or a juvenile's family in 3 accordance with a plan for the juvenile under section 43-285 or in 4 the context of a juvenile court proceeding relating to a juvenile 5 other than a juvenile who has been committed to a youth 6 rehabilitation and treatment center, if a service coordinator or 7 provider operating under a contract with the department, or a 8 subcontractor thereof, is unable or fails to provide such court-9 ordered treatment or services within five business days after 10 issuance of the court order, the department shall directly arrange for such treatment or services within three business days after the 11 12 failure of timely provision of such treatment or services as required 13 by this section, notwithstanding the provisions of any contract between the department and the service coordinator or provider. 14 (2) When the provision of treatment or services is a 15 16 matter of immediate and urgent necessity for the health, safety, or 17 welfare of a juvenile under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court and the service coordinator or provider operating under a contract 18 with the department, or any subcontractor thereof, is unable or fails 19 20 to provide such treatment or services immediately, the department 21 shall directly arrange for such treatment or services immediately, 22 notwithstanding the provisions of any contract between the department and the service coordinator or provider. 23 Sec. 2.
