7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>All contracts and agreements relating to the</u>	
2	medical assistance program as related to at-risk managed care for	
3	behavioral health services entered into by the department on or after	
4	July 1, 2012, shall:	
5	(1) Provide a definition and cap on administrative	
б	spending of seven percent;	
7	(2) Provide a definition of annual contractor profits and	
8	restrict such profits to a maximum of two and one-half percent per	
9	<u>year;</u>	
10	(3) Provide for reinvestment of any profits in excess of	
11	the contracted amount and any fees imposed by the department to fund	
12	community-based services for children, families, and adults according	
13	to a plan developed with stakeholder and regional behavioral health	
14	authority input and approved by the department. Such plan shall	
15	address the behavioral health needs of adults and children, including	
16	filling service gaps and providing system improvements;	
17	(4) Provide for a minimum medical loss ratio of eighty-	
18	five percent;	
19	(5) Provide that contractor performance guarantees and	
20	incentives not be more than one percent higher or lower than	
21	contracted or agreed to; and	
22	(6) Provide that a portion of contractor payments be	
23	contingent on performance metrics, with a minimum of one percent.

act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Behavioral Health
Services Act.
Sec. 3. Original section 71-801, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, is repealed.
Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
when passed and approved according to law.
