A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Uniform Credentialing Act; to amend  
2 section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to  
3 change provisions relating to issuance of credentials as  
4 prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to  
5 declare an emergency.  
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   38-129 No individual shall be issued a credential under  
4 the Uniform Credentialing Act until he or she has furnished  
5 satisfactory evidence to the department that he or she is of good  
6 character and has attained the age of nineteen years except as  
7 otherwise specifically provided by statute, rule, or regulation. A  
8 credential may only be issued to a citizen of the United States, an  
9 alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence into the United  
10 States who is eligible for a credential under the Uniform  
11 Credentialing Act, or a nonimmigrant ~~whose visa for entry, or~~  
12 ~~application for visa for entry, is related to such employment in the~~  
13 ~~United States.~~ lawfully present in the United States who is eligible  
14 for a credential under the Uniform Credentialing Act.

15                   Sec. 2. Original section 38-129, Reissue Revised Statutes  
16 of Nebraska, is repealed.

17                   Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect  
18 when passed and approved according to law.
