7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-1252, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 81-1252 (1) (1)(a) There is hereby created in the state
4 treasury a special fund to be known as the State Visitors Promotion
5 Cash Fund which shall be under the Department of Economic
6 Development.

7 (2) (b) The division of travel and tourism in the 8 Department of Economic Development shall use the proceeds of the State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund to generally promote, encourage, 9 and attract visitors to and within the State of Nebraska and enhance 10 the use of travel and tourism facilities within the state. The 11 12 proceeds of the State Visitors Promotion Cash Fund shall be in 13 addition to funds appropriated to the Department of Economic 14 Development, division of travel and tourism, from the state General 15 Fund.

16 (2) Beginning fiscal year 2011-12, no General Funds shall be appropriated to carry out the Nebraska Visitors Development Act. 17 Sec. 2. (1) This legislative bill is a result of the work 18 of the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the Legislature 19 20 pursuant to a legislative study resolution, LR 542, One Hundred First 21 Legislature, Second Session, 2010, introduced on April 1, 2010. 22 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that a budget 23 reduction of \$500,000 of General Funds appropriated to the Department

24 <u>of Economic Development in fiscal year 2011-12 and in fiscal year</u> 25 2012-13 be made as a result of the enactment of this legislative 1 <u>bill.</u>

Sec. 3. Original section 81-1252, Reissue Revised
 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

4 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect 5 when passed and approved according to law.
