1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1356 and section 2 of this
- 4 <u>act</u>shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 6 (a) Novelty lighter means a mechanical or electrical
- 7 device typically used for lighting cigarettes, cigars, or pipes and
- 8 (i) designed to resemble a cartoon character, a toy, a gun, a watch,
- 9 <u>a musical instrument, a vehicle, an animal, a food or beverage</u>
- 10 container, or a similar item, (ii) that plays musical notes, (iii)
- 11 that has flashing lights, or (iv) that has more than one button or
- 12 <u>function; and</u>
- 13 (b) Novelty lighter does not include:
- 14 (i) A lighter manufactured prior to January 1, 1980;
- 15 (ii) A lighter incapable of being fueled or lacking a
- 16 <u>device necessary to produce combustion or a flame; or</u>
- 17 <u>(iii) A standard disposable lighter that is printed or</u>
- 18 decorated with a logo, label, decal, artwork, or heat shrinkable
- 19 sleeve.
- 20 (2) It shall be unlawful to sell at retail, offer for
- 21 retail sale, or distribute for retail sale or promotion in this state
- 22 <u>a novelty lighter.</u>
- 23 (3) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
- of a Class IV misdemeanor.
