6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 16-251, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 16-251 The mayor and council of any city of the first 4 class shall have power to may establish and maintain public 5 libraries, reading rooms, art galleries, and museums, and to provide б the necessary grounds or buildings therefor; to purchase the papers, 7 books, maps, manuscripts, and works of art, and objects of natural or 8 scientific curiosity and instruction therefor; and to receive donations and bequests of money or property for the same public 9 10 libraries, reading rooms, art galleries, and museums in trust or otherwise. They The mayor and city council may also pass necessary 11 12 bylaws and regulations for the protection and government of the same. 13 public libraries, reading rooms, art galleries, and museums. The 14 ownership of the real and personal property of such a public library 15 shall be in the city. The mayor and city council shall approve any 16 personnel administrative or compensation policy or procedure applying to a director or employee of a public library, reading room, art 17 gallery, or museum before such policy or procedure is implemented. 18

19 Sec. 2. Section 51-211, Reissue Revised Statutes of 20 Nebraska, is amended to read:

51-211 (1) The library board shall have the power to may erect, lease, or occupy an appropriate building for the use of such a library, and to appoint a suitable librarian and assistants, to fix their the compensation of such appointees, and to remove such appointees at the pleasure of the board. The governing body of the

1 county, city, or village in which the library is located shall 2 approve any personnel administrative or compensation policy or 3 procedure before implementation of such policy or procedure by the 4 library board.

5 (2) The library board may It shall have the power to б establish rules and regulations for the government of such library as 7 may be deemed necessary for its preservation and to maintain its 8 usefulness and efficiency. It shall have the power to The library 9 board may fix and impose, by general rules, penalties and forfeitures 10 for trespasses upon or injury to the library grounds, rooms, books, or other property, for failure to return any book, or for violation 11 12 of any bylaw, rule, or regulation and to fix and impose reasonable 13 fees, not to exceed the library's actual cost, for nonbasic services. 14 The board shall have and exercise such power as may be necessary to carry out the spirit and intent of sections 51-201 to 51-219 in 15 establishing and maintaining a public library and reading room. 16

17 (2)-(3) The public library shall make its basic services 18 available without charge to all residents of the political 19 subdivision which supplies its tax support.

20 (3) (4) No service shall be denied to any person because
21 of race, sex, religion, age, color, national origin, ancestry,
22 physical handicap, or marital status.
