1 Section 1. Section 32-620, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 32-620 (1) Partisan candidates for the offices of

- 5 election ballot shall be certified to the Governor and Secretary of
- 6 State by the national nominating convention as provided by law.

7	represent the applicant as presidential elector candidates together

9	$\frac{(2)-(b)}{(b)}$ A petition signed by not less than two thousand
10	five hundred registered voters. Such petitions shall conform to the
11	requirements of section 32-628 and shall not be circulated until
12	after the date of the primary election in that election year.
13	Registered voters who voted in the primary election of any political
14	party that held a presidential preference primary election that year
15	shall be ineligible to sign the petitions of any other candidate for
16	president. be filed with the Secretary of State by August 1 in the
17	year of the presidential general election.
