- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska statutes; to amend section 49-707, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to create a fund; to change disposition of certain receipts; and to repeal the original section.

- 3 49-707 The Revisor of Statutes shall cause the
- 4 supplements and reissued volumes to be copyrighted under the
- 5 copyright laws of the United States for the benefit of the people of
- 6 Nebraska.
- 7 The supplements and reissued or replacement volumes shall
- 8 be sold and distributed by the Supreme Court at such price as shall
- 9 be prescribed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council,
- 10 which price shall be sufficient to recover all costs of publication.
- 11 The Supreme Court may sell for one dollar per volume any
- 12 compilation or revision of the statutes of Nebraska that has been
- 13 superseded by a later official revision, compilation, or replacement
- 14 volume. The Supreme Court may dispose of any unsold superseded
- 15 volumes in any manner it deems proper.
- 16 All money received by the Supreme Court <u>from the sale of</u>
- 17 the supplements and reissued or replacement volumes shall be paid
- 18 into the state treasury to the credit of the General Nebraska
- 19 Statutes Cash Fund. The court shall take receipts for all such money
- 20 paid into the state treasury. fund.
- 21 Supplements and reissued volumes shall be furnished and
- 22 delivered free of charge in the same number and to the same parties
- as are designated in section 49-617.
- Sec. 2. The Nebraska Statutes Cash Fund is created. Any
- 25 money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the
