A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to aeronautics; to amend section 3-404, Reissue
2	Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 3-126, Revised
3	Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2010; to provide for an
4	application fee for the construction of certain
5	structures; to harmonize provisions; to provide an
6	operative date; to repeal the original sections; and to
7	declare an emergency.
8	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 3-126, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:
- 3 3-126 The Department of Aeronautics Cash Fund is created.
- 4 All money received by the department pursuant to the State
- 5 Aeronautics Department Act and section 3-404 shall be remitted to the
- 6 State Treasurer for credit to the fund. The department is authorized,
- 7 whether acting for this state, as the agent of any of its
- 8 municipalities, or as the agent of any person owning a privately
- 9 owned public use airport, or when requested by the United States
- 10 Government or any agency or department thereof, to disburse such
- 11 money. Transfers may be made from the fund to the General Fund at the
- 12 direction of the Legislature through June 30, 2011. Any money in the
- 13 Department of Aeronautics Cash Fund available for investment shall be
- 14 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
- 15 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 16 Sec. 2. Section 3-404, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 17 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 18 3-404 The application for the permit, required by section
- 19 3-4037 shall be made in writing on forms prescribed by the Department
- 20 of Aeronautics and shall contain or be accompanied by details as to
- 21 the location, construction, height, and dimensions of the proposed
- 22 structure, the nature of its intended use, and such other information
- 23 as the Director of Aeronautics may require. The applicant shall
- 24 submit with the application a fee of seventy-five dollars. The
- 25 <u>director shall remit such fee to the State Treasurer for credit to</u>

the Department of Aeronautics Cash Fund. Upon the filing of such 1 2 application the director shall make an investigation and 3 aeronautical study of such proposed construction and its effect, if any, upon air navigation, and the health, welfare, and safety of the 4 5 public. If the director, upon such investigation, shall determine 6 determines that such proposed structure will not constitute a hazard 7 to air navigation and will not interfere unduly with the public right 8 of freedom of transit in commerce through the air space affected thereby, he shall issue to the applicant a permit, required by 9 section $3-403_{7}$ authorizing the erection and construction of such 10 structure, subject to such-conditions as to marking and lighting as 11 12 the department may prescribe by its rules and regulations, authorized 13 by adopted and promulgated pursuant to section 3-407. If he or she 14 does not so determine, he or she shall deny the application. In 15 making such investigation, aeronautical study, and determination, the director shall consider (1) the character of flying operations 16 expected to be conducted in the area concerned, (2) the nature of the 17 terrain, (3) the character of the neighborhood, (4) the uses to which 18 the property concerned is devoted or adaptable, (5) the proximity to 19 20 existing airports, airways, control areas, and control zones, (6) the height of existing, adjacent structures, and (7) all the facts and 21 circumstances existing. He or she shall impose only such restrictions 22 23 or requirements as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate the purpose of sections 3-401 to 3-409. 24

Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2011.

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Sec. 4. Original section 3-404, Reissue Revised Statutes

- 2 of Nebraska, and section 3-126, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 3 Supplement, 2010, are repealed.
- 4 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 5 when passed and approved according to law.
