### A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to certified nurse midwives; to amend sections

38-206, 38-603, 38-611, and 38-613, Reissue Revised

Statutes of Nebraska; to change and eliminate provisions

relating to scope of practice, authorized activities, and

practice agreements; to harmonize provisions; to repeal

the original sections; and to outright repeal sections

38-608, 38-609, 38-610, and 38-614, Reissue Revised

Statutes of Nebraska.

1 Section 1. Section 38-206, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 38-206 The board shall:
- 4 (1) Establish standards for integrated practice
- 5 agreements between collaborating physicians and certified nurse
- 6 midwives, and nurse practitioners;
- 7 (2) Monitor the scope of practice by certified nurse
- 8 midwives, certified registered nurse anesthetists, clinical nurse
- 9 specialists, and nurse practitioners;
- 10 (3) Recommend disciplinary action relating to licenses of
- 11 advanced practice registered nurses, certified nurse midwives,
- 12 certified registered nurse anesthetists, clinical nurse specialists,
- 13 and nurse practitioners;
- 14 (4) Engage in other activities not inconsistent with the
- 15 Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Practice Act, the Certified Nurse
- 16 Midwifery Practice Act, the Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist
- 17 Practice Act, the Clinical Nurse Specialist Practice Act, and the
- 18 Nurse Practitioner Practice Act; and
- 19 (5) Adopt rules and regulations to implement the Advanced
- 20 Practice Registered Nurse Practice Act, the Certified Nurse Midwifery
- 21 Practice Act, the Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist Practice
- 22 Act, the Clinical Nurse Specialist Practice Act, and the Nurse
- 23 Practitioner Practice Act, for promulgation by the department as
- 24 provided in section 38-126. Such rules and regulations shall also
- 25 include: (a) Approved certification organizations and approved

- 1 certification programs; and (b) professional liability insurance.
- 2 Sec. 2. Section 38-603, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 4 38-603 For purposes of the Certified Nurse Midwifery
- 5 Practice Act and elsewhere in the Uniform Credentialing Act, unless
- 6 the context otherwise requires, the definitions found in sections
- 7 38-604 to 38-610-38-607 apply.
- 8 Sec. 3. Section 38-611, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 9 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 10 38-611 A certified nurse midwife may, under the
- 11 provisions of a practice agreement, (1) attend practice nurse
- 12 midwifery. Such practice may include, but is not limited to, (1)
- 13 <u>attending</u> cases of normal childbirth, (2) <u>provide</u> <u>providing</u> prenatal,
- 14 intrapartum, and postpartum care, (3) provide providing normal
- 15 obstetrical and gynecological services for women, and (4) provide
- 16 providing care for the newborn immediately following birth. The
- 17 conditions under which a certified nurse midwife is required to refer
- 18 cases to a collaborating licensed practitioner shall be specified in
- 19 the practice agreement.
- Sec. 4. Section 38-613, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 21 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 22 38-613 (1) The specific medical health care functions to
- 23 be performed by a certified nurse midwife within the scope of
- 24 permitted practice prescribed by section 38-611 may be performed in
- 25 the following settings: shall be described in the practice agreement

1 which shall be reviewed and approved by the board. A copy of the 2 agreement shall be maintained on file with the board as a condition 3 of lawful practice under the Certified Nurse Midwifery Practice Act. 4 (2) A certified nurse midwife shall perform the functions 5 detailed in the practice agreement only under the supervision of the 6 licensed practitioner responsible for the medical care of the 7 patients described in the practice agreement. If the collaborating 8 licensed practitioner named in the practice agreement becomes 9 temporarily unavailable, the certified nurse midwife may perform the 10 authorized medical functions only under the supervision of another 11 licensed practitioner designated as a temporary substitute for that 12 purpose by the collaborating licensed practitioner. 13 (3) A certified nurse midwife may perform authorized medical functions only in the following settings: 14 15 (a) In a licensed or certified health care facility: as 16 an employee or as a person granted privileges by the facility; 17 (b) In the primary office of a licensed practitioner or 18 in any setting authorized by the collaborating licensed practitioner, 19 except that a certified nurse midwife shall not attend a home 20 delivery; or residence, office, or clinic of a certified nurse 21 midwife, a group of certified nurse midwives, or a group of licensed 22 practitioners or any distinct part of such residence, office, or 23 clinic;

(c) Within an organized public health agency; or -

(d) In any other setting approved by the board.

- 2 the board, adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out
- 3 the Certified Nurse Midwifery Practice Act.
- 4 Sec. 5. Original sections 38-206, 38-603, 38-611, and
- 5 38-613, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 6 Sec. 6. The following sections are outright repealed:
- 7 Sections 38-608, 38-609, 38-610, and 38-614, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 8 of Nebraska.
