1 Section 1. Section 49-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,141 <u>and section 3 of</u>
- 4 this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political
- 5 Accountability and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 49-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 7 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 8 49-1403 For purposes of the Nebraska Political
- 9 Accountability and Disclosure Act, unless the context otherwise
- 10 requires, the definitions found in sections 49-1404 to 49-1444 and
- 11 section 3 of this act shall be used.
- 12 Sec. 3. (1) Electioneering communication means any
- 13 <u>communication which:</u>
- 14 <u>(a) Refers to a clearly identified candidate;</u>
- (b) Is publicly distributed in the thirty days
- 16 immediately preceding an election for the office sought by the
- 17 clearly identified candidate; and
- 18 (c) Is directed to the electorate of the office sought by
- 19 the clearly identified candidate.
- 20 (2) Electioneering communication does not include:
- 21 <u>(a) A contribution or expenditure;</u>
- 22 (b) A communication by a television station, radio
- 23 station, newspaper, magazine, or other periodical or publication for
- 24 any news story, commentary, or editorial in support of or opposition
- 25 <u>to a candidate for elective office;</u>

1 (c) A candidate debate or forum or a communication which

- 2 gives notice of a candidate debate or forum; or
- 3 (d) A communication by a membership organization to the
- 4 membership organization's members when the member has paid a fee to
- 5 <u>be a member or has submitted a written document indicating intent to</u>
- 6 <u>be a member.</u>
- 7 Sec. 4. Section 49-1467, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 8 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 9 49-1467 (1) Any person, other than a committee, who makes
- 10 an independent expenditure advocating the election of a candidate or
- 11 the defeat of a candidate's opponents or the qualification, passage,
- 12 or defeat of a ballot question or who makes an electioneering
- 13 <u>communication</u>, which is in an amount of more than two hundred fifty
- 14 dollars, shall file a report of the independent expenditure or
- 15 <u>electioneering communication</u>, within ten days, with the commission.
- 16 (2) The report shall be made on an independent
- 17 expenditure or electioneering communication report form provided by
- 18 the commission and shall include the date of the expenditure or
- 19 <u>electioneering communication</u>, a brief description of the nature of
- 20 the expenditure or electioneering communication, the amount of the
- 21 expenditure or electioneering communication, the name and address of
- 22 the person to whom it was paid, the name and address of the person
- 23 filing the report, and the name, address, occupation, employer, and
- 24 principal place of business of each person who contributed more than
- 25 two hundred fifty dollars to the expenditure or electioneering

- 1 communication.
- 2 (3) The commission shall make all independent expenditure
- 3 or electioneering communication reports available to the public on
- 4 its web site as soon as practicable. An independent expenditure or
- 5 <u>electioneering communication</u> report shall be available on the web
- 6 site for the duration of the election period for which the report is
- 7 filed and for an additional six months thereafter.
- 8 (4) Any person who fails to file a report of an
- 9 independent expenditure or electioneering communication with the
- 10 commission shall pay to the commission a late filing fee of twenty-
- 11 five dollars for each day the statement remains not filed in
- 12 violation of this section not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars.
- 13 (5) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
- 14 of a Class IV misdemeanor.
- 15 Sec. 5. Section 49-1469, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 16 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 17 49-1469 (1) A corporation, labor organization, or
- 18 industry, trade, or professional association, which is organized
- 19 under the laws of the State of Nebraska or doing business in this
- 20 state and which is not a committee, may:
- 21 (a) Make an expenditure;
- 22 (b) Make a contribution; and
- 23 (c) Provide personal services; and -
- 24 (d) Make an electioneering communication.
- 25 (2) Such a corporation, labor organization, or industry,

1 trade, or professional association shall not be required to file

- 2 reports of independent expenditures or electioneering communications
- 3 pursuant to section 49-1467, but if it makes a contribution, or
- 4 expenditure, or electioneering communication, or provides personal
- 5 services, with a value of more than two hundred fifty dollars, it
- 6 shall file a report with the commission within ten days after the end
- 7 of the calendar month in which the contribution, or expenditure, or
- 8 <u>electioneering communication</u> is made or the personal services are
- 9 provided. The report shall include:
- 10 (a) The nature, date, and value of the contribution or
- 11 expenditure and the name of the candidate or committee or a
- 12 description of the ballot question to or for which the contribution
- 13 or expenditure was made; and
- 14 <u>(b) The nature, date, and value of the electioneering</u>
- 15 communication and the name of the candidate identified in the
- 16 <u>electioneering communication; and</u>
- 17 (b) (c) A description of any personal services provided,
- 18 the date the services were provided, and the name of the candidate or
- 19 committee or a description of the ballot question to or for which the
- 20 personal services were provided.
- 21 (3) A corporation, labor organization, or industry,
- 22 trade, or professional association may not receive contributions
- 23 unless it establishes and administers a separate segregated political
- 24 fund which shall be utilized only in the manner set forth in sections
- 25 49-1469.05 and 49-1469.06.
