- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Game Law; to amend sections 37-615 and 2 37-618, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide 3 for a hearing regarding privileges and permits suspended or revoked in other jurisdictions; to harmonize 4 5 provisions; and to repeal the original sections. 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-615, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 37-615 It shall be unlawful for any person to take any
- 4 species of wildlife protected by the Game Law while his or her
- 5 permits are revoked. It shall be unlawful for any person to apply for
- 6 or purchase a permit to hunt, fish, or harvest fur in Nebraska while
- 7 his or her permits are revoked and while the privilege to purchase
- 8 such permits is suspended. Any person who violates this section shall
- 9 be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor and in addition shall be
- 10 suspended from hunting, fishing, and fur harvesting or purchasing
- 11 permits to hunt, fish, and harvest fur for a period of not less than
- 12 two nor more than five years as the court directs. The court shall
- 13 consider the number and severity of the violations of the Game Law in
- 14 determining the length of the suspension.
- Any person whose privilege or permit to hunt, fish, or
- 16 harvest fur in another state has been suspended or revoked as a
- 17 result of a conviction shall not be eligible to obtain a permit to
- 18 hunt, fish, or harvest fur if the conviction would constitute grounds
- 19 for suspension or revocation under sections 37-614 to 37-617 until
- 20 the period of suspension or revocation in the other state has
- 21 expired.

- 24 37-618 Any (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 25 (3) of this section, any person whose privilege or permit to hunt,

1 fish, or harvest fur has been suspended or revoked in any

- 2 jurisdiction within the United States or Canada shall be prohibited
- 3 from obtaining a permit for such activity in this state during the
- 4 period of suspension or revocation in the prosecuting jurisdiction if
- 5 the offense for which the privilege or permit is suspended or revoked
- 6 is an offense under the Game Law or would constitute grounds for
- 7 <u>suspension or revocation under sections 37-614 to 37-617</u>.
- 8 (2) If such person has previously obtained a permit under
- 9 the Game Law for such activity, the permit shall become invalid and
- 10 shall be suspended for the same period as determined in the
- 11 prosecuting jurisdiction. The person shall immediately return the
- 12 permit to the commission. No person shall possess a permit which has
- 13 been suspended or revoked under this section except as otherwise
- 14 provided in subsection (3) of this section.
- 15 (3) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 16 regulations to create a process to allow a person whose privilege or
- 17 permit to hunt, fish, or harvest fur has been suspended or revoked in
- 18 any jurisdiction within the United States or Canada to request a
- 19 hearing before the commission to determine if the offense for which
- 20 the privilege or permit is suspended or revoked is an offense under
- 21 the Game law or would constitute grounds for suspension or revocation
- 22 <u>under sections 37-614 to 37-617.</u>
- 23 <u>(4) Any person who violates the provisions of this</u>
- 24 section shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.
