# A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-515,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 provisions relating to theft of services; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-515, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-515 (1) A person commits theft if he or she
- 4 <u>intentionally or knowingly</u> obtains services, which he or she knows
- 5 are available only for compensation, by deception or threat or by
- 6 false token or other means to avoid payment for the service. Services
- 7 include labor, professional service, telephone service, electric
- 8 service, cable television service, or other public service,
- 9 accommodation in hotels, restaurants, or elsewhere, admission to
- 10 exhibitions, and use of vehicles or other movable property. When
- 11 compensation for service is ordinarily paid immediately upon the
- 12 rendering of such service, as in the case of hotels and restaurants,
- 13 refusal to pay or absconding without payment or offer to pay gives
- 14 rise to a presumption that the service was obtained by deception as
- 15 to intention to pay.
- 16 (2) A person commits theft if, having control over the
- 17 disposition of services of others to which he or she is not entitled,
- 18 he or she intentionally or knowingly diverts such services to his or
- 19 her own benefit or to the benefit of another not entitled thereto.
- 20 (3)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (b) of this
- 21 <u>subsection</u>, a person commits theft if he or she intentionally or
- 22 knowingly secures the performance of a service by agreeing to provide
- 23 <u>compensation and, after the service is rendered, fails to make full</u>
- 24 payment after receiving notice demanding payment. For purposes of
- 25 this subdivision: (i) If the compensation is or was to be paid on a

1 periodic basis, the intent to avoid payment for a service may be

- 2 formed at any time during or before a pay period; and (ii) the
- 3 partial payment of wages alone is not sufficient evidence to negate
- 4 the person's intent to avoid payment for a service.
- 5 (b) When compensation for service is ordinarily paid
- 6 <u>immediately upon the rendering of such service, as in the case of</u>
- 7 hotels and restaurants, refusal to pay or absconding without payment
- 8 or offer to pay gives rise to a presumption that the service was
- 9 <u>obtained by deception as to intention to pay.</u>
