FOR AN ACT relating to court fees; to amend section 33-156, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to return indigent defense
fees collected in a county containing a city of the
metropolitan class to such county; to provide an
operative date; to repeal the original section; and to
declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 33-156 (1) In addition to all other court costs assessed
- 4 according to law, an indigent defense fee of three dollars shall be
- 5 taxed as costs for each case filed in each county court and district
- 6 court, including appeals to such courts, and for each appeal and
- 7 original action filed in the Court of Appeals and the Supreme Court.
- 8 The fees shall be remitted to the State Treasurer on forms prescribed
- 9 by the State Treasurer within ten days after the end of the month.
- 10 The State Treasurer shall: credit
- 11 (a) Remit the indigent defense fees collected in any
- 12 county containing a city of the metropolitan class to the county
- 13 treasurer of such county for credit to the indigent defense services
- 14 <u>fund for such county; and</u>
- 15 <u>(b) Credit</u> the <u>remaining</u> fees to the Commission on Public
- 16 Advocacy Operations Cash Fund.
- 17 (2) In cases under the DNA Testing Act, costs shall be
- 18 paid as provided in such act.
- 19 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2012.
- 20 Sec. 3. Original section 33-156, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 21 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 23 when passed and approved according to law.
