A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to authorize and appropriate
- 2 funds for renovation of certain living units at the Youth
- 3 Rehabilitation and Treatment Center-Kearney as
- 4 prescribed.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The Department of Health and Human Services is
2 hereby authorized to renovate the second-floor sleeping areas of the
3 Bryant/Creighton living unit at the Youth Rehabilitation and
4 Treatment Center-Kearney. The purpose of the renovation is to provide
5 the youth with a more private, homelike environment and with a
6 climate that is more conducive to treatment and rehabilitation
7 programs provided at the facility.

8 The Legislature shall appropriate \$XXX from the State
9 Building Fund for FY2012-13 to the Department of Health and Human
10 Services, for Program 942, for the renovation of the Bryant/Creighton
11 living unit at the Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment Center-Kearney.
12 It is the intent of the Legislature that all statutory requirements
13 of the state building division of the Department of Administrative
14 Services be met for this project before work begins.

15 Sec. 2. The Department of Health and Human Services is
16 hereby authorized to remodel the second-floor sleeping areas of the
17 Lincoln/Washington living unit at the Youth Rehabilitation and
18 Treatment Center-Kearney. The purpose of the renovation is to provide
19 the youth with a more private, homelike environment and with a
20 climate that is more conducive to treatment and rehabilitation
21 programs provided at the facility.

22 The Legislature shall appropriate \$XXX from the State
23 Building Fund for FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human
24 Services, for Program 942, for the renovation of the Lincoln/
25 Washington living unit at the Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment

1 Center-Kearney. It is the intent of the Legislature that all
2 statutory requirements of the state building division of the
3 Department of Administrative Services be met for this project before
4 work begins.
