## PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Avery, 28.

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF

- 2 NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2012 the
- 4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be
- 5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or
- 6 rejection:
- 7 To amend Article III, sections 7 and 19:
- 8 III-7 (1) At the general election to be held in November
- 9 1964, one-half the members of the Legislature, or as nearly thereto
- 10 as may be practicable, shall be elected for a term of four years and
- 11 the remainder for a term of two years, and thereafter all members
- 12 shall be elected for a term of four years, with the manner of such
- 13 election to be determined by the Legislature.
- 14 (2) When the Legislature is redistricted, the members
- 15 elected prior to the redistricting shall continue in office, and the
- 16 law providing for such redistricting shall where necessary specify
- 17 the newly established district which they shall represent for the
- 18 balance of their term.

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1 (3) Each member shall be nominated and elected in a

- 2 nonpartisan manner and without any indication on the ballot that he
- 3 or she is affiliated with or endorsed by any political party or
- 4 organization.
- 5 (4) This subsection terminates on the first Wednesday
- 6 <u>after the first Monday in January 2015.</u> Each member of the
- 7 Legislature shall receive a salary of not to exceed one thousand
- 8 dollars per month during the term of his or her office. In addition
- 9 to his or her salary, each member shall receive an amount equal to
- 10 his or her actual expenses in traveling by the most usual route once
- 11 to and returning from each regular or special session of the
- 12 Legislature. Members of the Legislature shall receive no pay nor
- 13 perquisites other than his or her salary and expenses, and employees
- 14 of the Legislature shall receive no compensation other than their
- 15 salary or per diem.
- 16 III-19 (1) The Legislature shall never grant any extra
- 17 compensation to any public officer, agent, or servant after the
- 18 services have been rendered nor to any contractor after the contract
- 19 has been entered into, except that retirement benefits of retired
- 20 public officers and employees may be adjusted to reflect changes in
- 21 the cost of living and wage levels that have occurred subsequent to
- 22 the date of retirement.
- 23 (2) The compensation of any public officer, including any
- 24 officer whose compensation is fixed by the Legislature, shall not be
- 25 increased or diminished during his or her term of office, except that

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1 when there are members elected or appointed to the Legislature or the

- 2 judiciary, or officers elected or appointed to a board or commission
- 3 having more than one member, and the terms of such members commence
- 4 and end at different times, the compensation of all members of the
- 5 Legislature, of the judiciary, or of such board or commission may be
- 6 increased or diminished at the beginning of the full term of any
- 7 member thereof.
- 8 (3) Nothing in this section shall prevent local governing
- 9 bodies from reviewing and adjusting vested pension benefits
- 10 periodically as prescribed by ordinance.
- 11 <u>(4)</u> The surviving spouse of any retired public officer,
- 12 agent, or servant, who has retired under a pension plan or system,
- 13 shall be considered as having pensionable status and shall be
- 14 entitled to the same benefits which may, at any time, be provided for
- 15 or available to spouses of other public officers, agents, or servants
- 16 who have retired under such pension plan or system at a later date,
- 17 and such benefits shall not be prohibited by the restrictions of this
- 18 section or of Article XIII, section 3 of the Constitution of
- 19 Nebraska.
- 20 (5) For purposes of establishing salary, travel expense,
- 21 and benefit provisions for state constitutional officers named in
- 22 Article IV, section 1, of this Constitution and for members of the
- 23 <u>Legislature</u>, the <u>Legislature</u> shall establish a compensation
- 24 <u>commission composed of members selected by the Legislature. The</u>
- 25 commission shall establish the salary, travel expense, and benefit

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1 provisions, and the Legislature shall appropriate funds for such

- 2 purposes.
- 3 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the
- 4 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,
- 5 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:
- A constitutional amendment to terminate constitutional
- 7 provisions regarding compensation of members and employees of the
- 8 Legislature and to provide for a compensation commission for state
- 9 constitutional officers and members of the Legislature.
