PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Pirsch, 4.

Read first time January 19, 2011

THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF
NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2012 the 4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be 5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or 6 rejection:

To amend Article III, sections 6 and 10:

8 III-6 The Legislature shall consist of not more than 9 fifty members and not less than thirty members. The sessions of the 10 Legislature shall be annual except as otherwise provided by this 11 constitution or as may be otherwise provided by law.

12 III-10 Beginning with the year 1975, regular <u>Regular</u> 13 sessions of the Legislature shall be held annually, <u>in odd-numbered</u> 14 <u>years</u> commencing at 10 a.m. on the first Wednesday after the first 15 Monday in January of each year. February. The terms of the members of 16 <u>the Legislature shall commence on the first day of the regular</u> 17 <u>session and, notwithstanding the provisions of Article III, section</u> 18 <u>7, of this Constitution, the preceding terms shall terminate on such</u>

date. The duration of regular sessions held shall not exceed ninety 1 2 legislative days in odd-numbered years unless extended by a vote of 3 four-fifths of all members elected to of the Legislature., and shall 4 not exceed sixty legislative days in even-numbered years unless 5 extended by a vote of four-fifths of all members elected to the 6 Legislature. Bills and resolutions under consideration by the 7 Legislature upon adjournment of a regular session held in an odd-8 numbered year may be considered at the next regular session, as if 9 there had been no such adjournment. The Lieutenant Governor shall 10 preside, but shall vote only when the Legislature is equally divided. A majority of the members elected to <u>of</u> the Legislature shall 11 12 constitute a quorum. The ; the Legislature shall determine the rules 13 of its proceedings, and be the judge of the election, returns, and qualifications of its members, shall and choose its own officers, 14 15 including a Speaker to preside when the Lieutenant Governor shall be 16 is_absent, incapacitated, or shall act acting_as Governor. No member shall be expelled except by a vote of two-thirds of all members 17 18 elected to of the Legislature, and no member shall be twice expelled 19 for the same offense. The Legislature may punish by imprisonment any 20 person not a member thereof who shall be is guilty of disrespect to 21 the Legislature by disorderly or contemptuous behavior in its presence, but no such imprisonment shall extend beyond twenty-four 22 23 hours at one time, unless the person shall persist persists in such 24 disorderly or contemptuous behavior.

electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, 1 2 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language: 3 A constitutional amendment to provide for regular 4 sessions of the Legislature only in odd-numbered years, to change the 5 date on which regular sessions will commence, to change the date on б which the terms of members will commence, and to change the date on 7 which the terms of certain members will terminate. 8 For 9 Against.
