Introducer's Statement of Intent

Date of Hearing: January 31, 2011

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The provisions of this bill provides that any person moving an oversized structure on county or township roads must notify the local authority (entity responsible for the road) and the electric utility if objects are over 15.5 feet high or wider than the road traveled are being moved. If electric utility infrastructure is not present notification to the electric utility is not necessary. Notification must be made ten days prior to moving the oversized structure.

Complying with the notification requirement does not exempt an individual from complying with any other federal, state or local authority permit or notification requirements.

Failure to comply with the notification is a Class III Misdemeanor.
