Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB395

Date of Hearing: February 16, 2011

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 395 would require directors, secretary, chief executive officer and designee to be nonvoting advisory members of the Environmental Trust Board. Any member of the board who is also director of a state agency is able to vote on applications which would provide funding primarily to their agency. LB 395 would also require no less than five members to cast affirmative votes to be able to deviate from the subcommittee's recommendations.
