## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Clarifies notification provisions for natural gas utility operators under the One-Call Notification System Act. Defines bar test survey. Amends 76-2329 to add a new section to exclude bar test surveys from 76-2321, the requirement to give notice to all utilities, and 76-2323, the requirement to mark locations of underground facilities. Adds a new section to exclude excavation performed by natural gas operators due to an emergency from the notification requirement. Exempts the operator from civil liabilities as laid out in 76-2325. Operators will still be strictly liable for damages to other utility lines.
