Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB7 eliminates the requirement of both a signature and a seal under the statute, requiring only a seal by a licensed architect or professional engineer in each technical submission filed or issued for public record. The bill modifies the requirements of the seal so the contents are consistent regardless of whether the seal is submitted electronically or in writing. It also requires the seal contain the language "State of Nebraska" and "Architect" or "Professional Engineer." LB 7 prohibits the architect, or professional, from affixing their seal to required technical submissions unless the submissions were prepared by the architect, under his or her direct supervision, or by an agent thereof. The bill removes the requirement of an electronic revision approval system.
