Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 743 provides that the term of any person elected to serve a four-year term in a governmental body starts on the day of the meeting of the body at which members are sworn into office. The second half of the term starts on the day of the meeting of the body at which members are sworn in to office in the second calendar year after the term begins.

These provisions do not apply to the State Board of Education.
