Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR444 creates the Tax Incentive Evaluation Committee as a special legislative committee. The committee shall develop recommendations for:

- a. Specific and measurable goals for each tax incentive program;
- b. A process for the regular evaluation of tax incentives;
- c. Who should conduct the evaluations and the types of metrics to be used;
- d. How often the evaluations should be conducted; and
- e. Proposed legislation for ongoing evaluations in statute.

The committee shall be comprised of the members of the Performance Audit Committee, the chair and vice-chair of the Appropriations Committee, the chair and vice-chair of the Revenue Committee, and one other member of the Legislature selected by the Executive Board.

A report shall be issued to the Executive Board not later than December 15, 2014.
