COMMENTS: The Supreme Court fiscal note on LB 313 identifies that potential cost savings from probation staff currently assigned to the Work Ethic Camp will be utilized to cover other existing needs for staffing in other areas of Probation services, so there will be no overall impact to the agency as a result of the bill. While changes to the overall Probation budget and expenditures might not change (but that will be a factor of Appropriation Committee and Legislative decisions about the Supreme Court budget in LB 195 and elsewhere), specific Program staffing levels and costs will be impacted as a result of the bill.
