Section 1. Section 71-2454, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3 71-2454 It is the intent of the Legislature that an described in section 71-2455 establish a system 4 entity of 5 prescription drug monitoring for the purposes of (1) preventing the 6 misuse of prescription drugs controlled substances that are 7 prescribed in an efficient and cost-effective manner and (2) allowing 8 doctors and pharmacists to monitor the care and treatment of patients for whom such a prescription drug is prescribed to ensure that such 9 prescription drugs are used for medically appropriate purposes and 10 11 that the State of Nebraska remains on the cutting edge of medical 12 information technology.

13 Sec. 2. Section 71-2455, Revised Statutes Cumulative
14 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

71-2455 The Department of Health and Human Services, in 15 16 collaboration with the Nebraska Health Information Initiative or any successor public-private statewide health information exchange, shall 17 18 enhance or establish technology for prescription drug monitoring to 19 carry out the purposes of section 71-2454. No state funding shall be 20 used to implement or operate the prescription drug monitoring system 21 provided for in this section. The department may use state funds and 22 accept grants, gifts, or other funds in order to implement and 23 operate the technology. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to authorize use of electronic health information, if 24 25 necessary to carry out the purposes of sections 71-2454 and 71-2455.

1	Sec. 3. The Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Fund is
2	created. The Department of Health and Human Services shall administer
3	the fund which shall include any state funds, grants, or gifts
4	received by the department for the purposes of carrying out the
5	purposes of sections 71-2454 and 71-2455. Any money in the fund
6	available for investment shall be invested by the state investment
7	officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the
8	<u>Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.</u>
9	Sec. 4. Original sections 71-2454 and 71-2455, Revised
10	Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
