A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the One-Call Notification System Act; to amend
2 sections 76-2322 and 76-2330, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska; to change requirements for serving notice of
4 intent to excavate; to harmonize provisions; and to
5 repeal the original sections.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 76-2322, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 76-2322 An excavator shall serve notice of intent to
4 excavate upon the center by ~~calling the center's toll-free telephone~~
5 ~~number.~~ submitting a locate request using a method provided by the
6 center. The center shall inform the excavator of all operators to
7 whom such notice will be transmitted and shall promptly transmit such
8 notice to every operator having an underground facility in the area
9 of intended excavation. The center shall assign an identification
10 number to each notice received.

11 Sec. 2. Section 76-2330, Reissue Revised Statutes of
12 Nebraska, is amended to read:

13 76-2330 The center shall:

14 (1) Maintain adequate records documenting compliance with
15 the requirements of the One-Call Notification System Act, including
16 records of all telephone calls and records of all ~~location~~-locate
17 requests for the preceding five years which will be made available
18 and printed upon request of an operator or excavator;

19 (2) Provide the notification service during normal
20 working hours at a minimum; and

21 (3) Provide procedures for emergency notification for
22 calls received at other than normal working hours.

23 Sec. 3. Original sections 76-2322 and 76-2330, Reissue
24 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
