## A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Civic and Community Center Financing Act;
2	to amend section 13-2706, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3	Nebraska, and sections 13-2703, 13-2705, 13-2707,
4	13-2707.01, and 13-2709, Revised Statutes Supplement,
5	2013; to authorize grants to certain county agricultural
6	societies; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the
7	original sections; and to declare an emergency.
8	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 13-2703, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2 2013, is amended to read: 3 13-2703 For purposes of the Civic and Community Center 4 Financing Act: 5 (1) Applicant means a municipality or a county б agricultural society in a county with a population of less than one 7 thousand; 8 (1) (2) Civic center means a facility that is primarily used to host conventions, meetings, and cultural events and a 9 10 library; 11 (2) (3) Community center means the traditional center of 12 a community, typically comprised of a cohesive core of residential, 13 civic, religious, and commercial buildings, arranged around a main street and intersecting streets; 14 (3) (4) Department means the Department of Economic 15 16 Development; 17 (4) (5) Fund means the Civic and Community Center Financing Fund; 18 (5) (6) Historic building means a building eligible for 19 20 listing on or currently listed on the National Register of Historic 21 Places; and (6) <u>(7)</u> Recreation center means a facility used for 22 23 athletics, fitness, sport activities, or recreation that is owned by a municipality an applicant and is available for use by the general 24 public with or without charge. Recreation center does not include any 25

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1 facility that requires a person to purchase a membership to utilize 2 such facility. 3 Sec. 2. Section 13-2705, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013, is amended to read: 4 5 13-2705 The department may conditionally approve grants of assistance from the fund to eligible and competitive applicants б 7 within the following limits: 8 (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this 9 section, a grant request shall be in an amount meeting the following 10 requirements: 11 (a) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01, 12 at least ten thousand dollars but no more than: 13 (i) For a city of the primary class, one million five 14 hundred thousand dollars; (ii) For a municipality with a population of forty 15 thousand but less than one hundred thousand, seven hundred fifty 16 17 thousand dollars; (iii) For a municipality with a population of twenty 18 thousand but less than forty thousand, five hundred thousand dollars; 19 20 (iv) For a municipality with a population of ten thousand but less than twenty thousand, four hundred thousand dollars; and 21 (v) For a municipality with a population of less than ten 22 23 thousand or a county agricultural society, two hundred fifty thousand dollars; and 24 25 (b) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.02,

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at least two thousand dollars but no more than ten thousand dollars; 1 2 (2) Upon the balance of the fund reaching two million five hundred thousand dollars, and until the balance of the fund 3 falls below one million dollars, a grant request shall be in an 4 5 amount meeting the following requirements: (a) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01, 6 7 at least ten thousand dollars but no more than: 8 (i) For a city of the primary class, two million two hundred fifty thousand dollars; 9 (ii) For a municipality with a population of forty 10 thousand but less than one hundred thousand, one million one hundred 11 12 twenty-five thousand dollars; 13 (iii) For a municipality with a population of twenty thousand but less than forty thousand, seven hundred fifty thousand 14 15 dollars; 16 (iv) For a municipality with a population of ten thousand but less than twenty thousand, six hundred thousand dollars; and 17 18 (v) For a municipality with a population of less than ten thousand or a county agricultural society, three hundred seventy-five 19 20 thousand dollars; and (b) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.02, 21 22 at least two thousand dollars but no more than ten thousand dollars; 23 (3) Assistance from the fund shall not amount to more than fifty percent of the cost of the project for which a grant is 24 25 requested; and

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(4) A municipality An applicant shall not be awarded more 2 than one grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01 and one grant 3 of assistance under section 13-2704.02 in any five-year period. Section 13-2706, Reissue Revised Statutes of 4 5 Nebraska, is amended to read: 13-2706 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this 6 7 section for a city of the primary class, any municipality applicant 8 that has applied for and received a grant of assistance under the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act shall not receive state assistance under the Civic and Community Center Financing Act for the same project for which the grant was awarded under the Sports 11 12 Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act. 13 (2) A city of the primary class shall not be eligible to receive a grant of assistance from the Civic and Community Center 14 Financing Act if the city has applied for and received a grant of 15 assistance under the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance Act. 16 (3) Any city applicant that has received funding under 18 the Convention Center Facility Financing Assistance Act shall not receive state assistance under the Civic and Community Center 20 Financing Act. (4) Any municipality applicant eligible for a grant of 21

22 assistance as provided in this section may apply for a grant of 23 assistance from the fund. Application shall be made on forms developed by the department. 24

25 Sec. 4. Section 13-2707, Revised Statutes Supplement,

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1 2013, is amended to read:

2 13-2707 (1) The department shall evaluate all 3 applications for grants of assistance under section 13-2704.01 based 4 on the following criteria, which are listed in no particular order of 5 preference:

6 (a) Retention Impact. Funding decisions by the department 7 shall be based on the likelihood of the project retaining existing 8 residents in the community where the project is located, developing, 9 sustaining, and fostering community connections, and enhancing the 10 potential for economic growth in a manner that will sustain the 11 quality of life and promote long-term economic development;

12 (b) New Resident Impact. Funding decisions by the 13 department shall be based on the likelihood of the project attracting 14 new residents to the community where the project is located;

15 (c) Visitor Impact. Funding decisions by the department 16 shall be based on the likelihood of the project enhancing or creating 17 an attraction that would increase the potential of visitors to the 18 community where the project is located from inside and outside the 19 state;

20 (d) Readiness. The applicant's fiscal and economic 21 capacity to finance the local share and ability to proceed and 22 implement its plan and operate the civic center, community center, or 23 recreation center; and

(e) Project Planning. Projects with completed technicalassistance and feasibility studies shall be preferred to those with

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1 no prior planning.

2 (2) Any grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01
3 shall be matched at least equally from local sources. At least fifty
4 percent of the local match must be in cash.

5 (3) To receive a grant of assistance under section 6 13-2704.01, the project for which the grant is requested shall be 7 located in the municipality that applies for the grant <u>or owned by</u> 8 <u>the county agricultural society that applies for the grant</u>.

9 Sec. 5. Section 13-2707.01, Revised Statutes Supplement,
10 2013, is amended to read:

11 13-2707.01 The department shall evaluate all applications 12 for grants of assistance under section 13-2704.02 based on the 13 following criteria:

(1) Financial Support. Assistance from the fund shall be matched at least equally from local sources. At least fifty percent of the local match must be in cash. Projects with a higher level of local matching funds shall be preferred as compared to those with a lower level of matching funds; and

19 (2) Project Location. Assistance from the fund shall be 20 for engineering and technical studies related to projects that will 21 be located in the municipality that applies for the grant <u>or projects</u> 22 <u>owned by the county agricultural society that applies for the grant</u>.

24 2013, is amended to read:

25 13-2709 The department shall submit, as part of the

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1 department's annual status report under section 81-1201.11, the 2 following information regarding the Civic and Community Center 3 Financing Act:

4 (1) Information documenting the grants conditionally
5 approved for funding by the Legislature in the following fiscal year;
6 (2) Reasons why a full application was not sent to any
7 municipality applicant seeking assistance under the act;

8 (3) The amount of sales tax revenue generated for the 9 fund pursuant to subsection (4) of section 13-2610 and subsection (6) 10 of section 13-3108, the total amount of grants applied for under the 11 act, the year-end fund balance, and, if all available funds have not 12 been committed to funding grants under the act, an explanation of the 13 reasons why all such funds have not been so committed;

14 (4) The amount of appropriated funds actually expended by15 the department for the year;

16 (5) The department's current budget for administration of 17 the act and the department's planned use and distribution of funds, 18 including details on the amount of funds to be expended on grants and 19 the amount of funds to be expended by the department for 20 administrative purposes; and

(6) Grant summaries, including the applicant, municipality, project description, grant amount requested, amount and type of matching funds, and reasons for approval or denial based on evaluation criteria from section 13-2707 or 13-2707.01 for every application seeking assistance under the act.

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Sec. 7. Original section 13-2706, Reissue Revised
 Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 13-2703, 13-2705, 13-2707,
 13-2707.01, and 13-2709, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013, are
 repealed.
 Sec. 8. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect

6 when passed and approved according to law.
