A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Dentistry Practice Act; to amend section 2 38-1130, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change 3 functions authorized and authorization requirements for licensed dental hygienists; and to repeal the original 5 section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 38-1130, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 38-1130 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 4 a licensed dental hygienist shall perform the dental hygiene
- 5 functions listed in section 38-1131 only when authorized to do so by
- 6 a licensed dentist who shall be responsible for the total oral health
- 7 care of the patient.
- 8 (2) The department may authorize a licensed dental
- 9 hygienist to perform the following functions in the conduct of public
- 10 health-related services in a public health setting or in a health
- 11 care or related facility: Preliminary charting and screening
- 12 examinations; oral health education, including workshops and
- 13 inservice training sessions on dental health; and all of the duties
- 14 that any dental assistant is authorized to perform.
- 15 (3)(a) The department may authorize a licensed dental
- 16 hygienist with three thousand hours of clinical experience in at
- 17 least four of the preceding five calendar years to perform the
- 18 following functions in the conduct of public health-related services
- 19 to children in a public health setting or in a health care or related
- 20 facility: Oral prophylaxis to healthy children who do not require
- 21 antibiotic premedication; pulp vitality testing; and preventive
- 22 measures, including the application of fluorides, sealants, and other
- 23 recognized topical agents for the prevention of oral disease.
- 24 (b) Authorization shall be granted by the department
- 25 under this subsection upon (i) filing an application with the

1 department, and (ii) providing evidence of current licensure and

- 2 professional liability insurance coverage. , and (iii) providing
- 3 evidence of clinical experience as required under subdivision (a) of
- 4 this subsection. Authorization may be limited by the department as
- 5 necessary to protect the public health and safety upon good cause
- 6 shown and may be renewed in connection with renewal of the dental
- 7 hygienist's license.
- 8 (c) A licensed dental hygienist performing dental hygiene
- 9 functions as authorized under this subsection shall (i) report
- 10 authorized functions performed by him or her to the department and
- 11 (ii) advise the patient or recipient of services or his or her
- 12 authorized representative that such services are preventive in nature
- 13 and do not constitute a comprehensive dental diagnosis and care.
- 14 <u>(4)(a) The department may authorize a licensed dental</u>
- 15 hygienist who has completed three thousand hours of clinical
- 16 experience to perform the following functions in the conduct of
- 17 public health-related services to adults in a public health setting
- 18 or in a health care or related facility: Oral prophylaxis; pulp
- 19 vitality testing; and preventive measures, including the application
- 20 of fluorides, sealants, and other recognized topical agents for the
- 21 prevention of oral disease.
- 22 (b) Authorization shall be granted by the department
- 23 <u>under this subsection upon (i) filing an application with the</u>
- 24 department, (ii) providing evidence of current licensure and
- 25 professional liability insurance coverage, and (iii) providing

1 evidence of three thousand hours of clinical experience.

- 2 Authorization may be limited by the department as necessary to
- 3 protect the public health and safety upon good cause shown and may be
- 4 renewed in connection with renewal of the dental hygienist's license.
- 5 (c) A licensed dental hygienist performing dental hygiene
- 6 functions as authorized under this subsection shall (i) report
- 7 <u>authorized functions performed by him or her to the department and</u>
- 8 (ii) advise the patient or recipient of services or his or her
- 9 authorized representative that such services are preventive in nature
- 10 and do not constitute a comprehensive dental diagnosis and care.
- 11 $\frac{(4)-(5)}{(5)}$ For purposes of this section:
- 12 (a) Health care or related facility means a hospital, a
- 13 nursing facility, an assisted-living facility, a correctional
- 14 facility, a tribal clinic, or a school-based preventive health
- 15 program; and
- 16 (b) Public health setting means a federal, state, or
- 17 local public health department or clinic, community health center,
- 18 rural health clinic, or other similar program or agency that serves
- 19 primarily public health care program recipients.
- 20 <u>(6) Within five years after the effective date of this</u>
- 21 act, the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature shall
- 22 evaluate the services provided by dental hygienists pursuant to this
- 23 <u>section to ascertain the effectiveness of such services in the</u>
- 24 <u>delivery of oral health care</u>.
