A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to state intent; and to
- 2 require an upgrade of an electronic data collection
- 3 system as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) It is the intent of the Legislature to

- 2 appropriate \$XXX to:
- 3 (a) Improve the data information and management system in
- 4 the child welfare system by incorporating web-based technologies and
- 5 eliminating dependence on mainframe computers, the CA Gen development
- 6 platform, and CA-Aion Business Rules software;
- 7 (b) Retain system integration between child welfare
- 8 services and other economic assistance programs; and
- 9 (c) Address child welfare reporting requirements.
- 10 (2) The Department of Health and Human Services shall
- 11 upgrade the N-FOCUS system as defined in section 43-4401 by migrating
- 12 the system to open systems standards and platforms. The department
- 13 shall ensure that the upgrade keeps the N-FOCUS system qualified for
- 14 federal funding as a statewide automated child welfare information
- 15 system pursuant to 45 C.F.R. 1355.50 through 1355.57, implementing
- 16 section 474(a)(3)(C) and (D) of Title IV-E of the federal Social
- 17 Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 674(a)(3)(C) and (D), as such regulations and
- 18 section existed on January 1, 2013, and shall migrate the N-FOCUS
- 19 system to a web-based, open-systems technology.
- 20 (3) The Department of Health and Human Services and the
- 21 office of the Chief Information Officer shall adopt, with guidance
- 22 from the report completed pursuant to section 43-4405, a strategic
- 23 plan and schedule for the upgrade required by this section. The
- 24 department shall develop and file federal Planning Advance Planning
- 25 Documents to request federal funding for the statewide automated

child welfare information system pursuant to 45 C.F.R. 1355.50 1 2 through 1355.57, implementing section 474(a)(3)(C) and (D) of Title IV-E of the federal Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 674(a)(3)(C) and 3 4 (D), as such regulations and section existed on January 1, 2013. The 5 planning advance planning document shall describe the proposed plan 6 for managing the design, development, and operation of a statewide 7 automated child welfare information system that meets such federal 8 requirements and the state's needs in an efficient, comprehensive, 9 and cost-effective manner. The strategic plan shall comply with the 10 requirements of the Administration for Children and Families of the United States Department of Health and Human Services that the N-11 12 FOCUS and the Children Have a Right to Support systems have increased 13 information interface and that all child welfare service provider payments be made on the N-FOCUS system. 14 15 (4) On or before December 31, 2013, the Department of 16 Health and Human Services and the Department of Administrative Services shall develop a request for proposals and award the contract 17 for the first stages of the upgrade of the N-FOCUS system and file 18 the required federal Implementation Advance Planning Document for 19 20 each participating federal agency.
