### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act; to
  amend section 48-101.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
  Supplement, 2012; to change provisions relating to mental
  injuries and mental illness compensation; and to repeal
  the original section.
  Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 48-101.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 48-101.01 (1) Personal injury includes mental injuries
- 4 and mental illness unaccompanied by physical injury for an employee
- 5 who is a first responder or coroner if such first responder or
- 6 coroner:
- 7 (a) Establishes, by a preponderance of the evidence, that
- 8 the employee's employment conditions causing the mental injury or
- 9 mental illness were extraordinary and unusual in comparison to the
- 10 normal conditions of the particular employment; and
- 11 (b) Establishes, by a preponderance of the evidence, the
- 12 medical causation between the mental injury or mental illness and the
- 13 employment conditions by medical evidence.
- 14 (2) For purposes of this section, mental injuries and
- 15 mental illness arising out of and in the course of employment
- 16 unaccompanied by physical injury are not considered compensable if
- 17 they result from any event or series of events which are incidental
- 18 to normal employer and employee relations, including, but not limited
- 19 to, personnel actions by the employer such as disciplinary actions,
- 20 work evaluations, transfers, promotions, demotions, salary reviews,
- 21 or terminations.
- 22 (3) For purposes of this section, first responder means a
- 23 sheriff, a deputy sheriff, a police officer, an officer of the
- 24 Nebraska State Patrol, a volunteer or paid firefighter, or a
- 25 volunteer or paid individual licensed under a licensure

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1 classification in subdivision (1) of section 38-1217 who provides

- 2 medical care in order to prevent loss of life or aggravation of
- 3 physiological or psychological illness or injury.
